- 1. Now we know how to please the living God today! I Thess 4:1 Furthermore then we beseech you, brethren, and exhort you by the Lord Jesus, that as ye have received of us how ye ought to walk and to please God, so ye would abound more and more. Rom 8:8,9 So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God. But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his. I Thess 1:9,10 For they themselves shew of us what manner of entering in we had unto you, and how ye turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God; And to wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead, even Jesus, which delivered us from the wrath to come. Act 26:20, But shewed first unto them of Damascus, and at Jerusalem, and throughout all the coasts of Judaea, and then to the Gentiles, that they should repent and turn to God, and do works meet for repentance.
- 2. We can now have a complete and mature understanding not just 'in part.' II Tim 2:7 Consider what I say; and the Lord give thee understanding in all things. Col 1:9 For this cause we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of his will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; I Cor 14:20 Brethren, be not children in understanding: howbeit in malice be ye children, but in understanding be men. Eph 1:18 The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints... (in the tribulation, understanding will be as God gives it in part). 1 Jn 5:20 And we know that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, even in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life. I Jn 2:27 But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him.

3. Learn the 'way of God' more perfectly! "Perfect" is defined in II Chronicles 8:15 to mean complete, finished. Now all the work of Solomon was prepared unto the day of the foundation of the house of the LORD, and until it was finished. So the house of the LORD was perfected. Jesus taught 'the way of God' to the Jews: Matthew 22:16 - Master, we know that thou art true, and teachest the way of God in

truth. However, Paul teaches 'the way of God more perfectly' to the Gentiles (us

today) - Acts 18:26 ...they took him unto them, and expounded unto him the way of

- God more perfectly.

 4. Learn a more excellent way with Paul now! I Corinthians 12:31b ...and yet shew I unto you a more excellent way.
- 5. Learning that we are our own worst enemy We can only escape Satan's snare by acknowledging the truth and then doing something about it. II Tim 2:25,26, In meekness instructing those that oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the truth; And that they may recover

themselves out of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will.

6. God changes us by 'making' us free, (Rom 6:18,22; 8:2; Gal 5:1) He does not set us free like all the modern bibles say (soon, but not now). There is no need for confession of sins (I Jn 1:9 – Jews only) or asking for more forgiveness as He simply does not impute our sins to us (Rom 4:8); how can He do this? He changes us – He

makes us dead to sin (Rom 6:11), He makes us dead to the law (Rom 7:6 - Gal 2:19),

- Who gave himself for our sins, that he might deliver us from this present evil world... (Gal 1:4), He completely forgives us, (Acts 26:18) He cuts us away from our flesh/sin Colossians 2:11-15so we can only build upon our foundation, (anything else will burn
- in our judgment seat of Christ. (I Corinthians 3:10).7. We learn that we are living during the true New Testament from

Paul, not from Peter or any of the twelve apostles or Matthew, Mark, Luke, John or Hebrews through Jude. Hebrews 9:16,17 - For where a testament is, there must also of necessity be the death of the testator. For a testament is of force after men are dead: otherwise it is of no strength at all while the testator liveth. John 7:39 ... for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.) Acts 1-8 was Christ offering Himself one more time to His people through Peter and Stephen.

- 8. Made nigh unto Christ Ephesians 2:13 But now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ.
- 9. Learn of the fellowship of the mystery Ephesians 3:9 And to make all men see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, who created all things by Jesus Christ:
- 10. Dispensation of the grace of God Ephesians 3:1,2 For this cause I Paul, the prisoner of Jesus Christ for you Gentiles, If ye have heard of the dispensation of the grace of God which is given me to you-ward:
- 11. Paul's gospel of the RISEN Saviour to be our only gospel today -Galatians 1:8,9 But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed. As we said before, so say I now again, If any man preach any other gospel unto you than that ye have received, let him be accursed.
- 12. Paul is our ensample, NOT our example! We are to 'follow' Paul, NOT 'imitate' Paul. I Corinthians 11:1 Be ye followers of me, even as I also am of Christ. Galatians 1:8, But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed. Note: Many modern 'Bibles' tell their readers to imitate God, imitate Christ, imitate the apostles and imitate the faith of their pastor.
- 13. We concern ourselves about the kingdom of God, not the kingdom of heaven which was and will be a physical, visible earthly kingdom. Paul preaches a spiritual 'only' kingdom from the risen Christ. Rom 14:17 For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost. Act 28:31 Preaching the kingdom of God, and teaching those things which concern the Lord Jesus Christ, with all confidence, no man forbidding him.

- 14. Paul as our ONLY apostle, minister, teacher to the Gentiles II Tim 1:11 Whereunto I am appointed a preacher, and an apostle, and a teacher of the Gentiles. II Tim 1:1 Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, according to the promise of life which is in Christ Jesus, I Tim 2:7 Whereunto I am ordained a preacher, and an apostle, (I speak the truth in Christ, and lie not;) a teacher of the Gentiles in faith and verity. Titus 1:1 Paul, a servant of God, and an apostle of Jesus Christ, according to the faith of God's elect, and the acknowledging of the truth which is after godliness; Paul first went to the Jews showing them Jesus is the son of God Acts 9:20, (wrote Heb) but Paul was rejected; he went on to the Gentiles with goodness of God.
- 15. Paul's serious and detailed prayers for us and others as our ensample (but not as vain repetitions from us). Rom 1:9 For God is my witness, whom I serve with my spirit in the gospel of his Son, that without ceasing I make mention of you always in my prayers; See also Eph 1:16-19; 3:13-19; 4:17-24; Phil 1:9-11; Col 1:9-11.
- 16. Paul's Concerns for Us: II Cor 11:34, But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent beguiled Eve through his subtilty, so your minds should be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ. For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him.
- 17. We can now see God 'face to face' and learn, no longer in part, but all we want to learn is available, 'in full, simply by reading and studying the KJB I Cor 13:9,10,12, For we know in part, and we prophesy in part. But when that which is perfect is come, then that which is in part shall be done away. For now we see through a glass, darkly; but then face to face: now I know in part; but then shall I know even as also I am known.
- 18. Discernment now comes from the KJB, "Then..." in part I Cor 12:10 To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues: But when... I Cor 13:10, But when that which is perfect is come, then that which is in part shall be done away. Now I Cor 13:12b then shall I know even as also I am known. Hebrews 4:12 For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

19. We learn that it isn't 'us' sinning, *if* you are truly quickened by the risen Christ, as taught by Paul, from a rightly divided King James Bible! If you can grasp the '*operation made without hands*,' then hopefully you can grasp this doctrine! This makes the joy and peace of true Christianity. NOBODY teaches this except in a few Bible Believing KJB churches – maybe correctly.

Romans 7:15-25.

For that which I do I allow not: for what I would, that do I not; but what I hate, that do I.

(These verses in I John do not affect the truth of Romans 7:15-25 today! - Only for tribulation) I Jn 1:8,10, If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.

II Timothy 2:15 - Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth. When you rightly divide the scriptures – the word of truth, you find comfort in the simple but yet magnificent fact that the risen Saviour has already MADE you approved unto God and there is nothing you can do now that should make you feel ashamed to God, other than the shame those modern conceited and deceived Christian judgmental shamethrowers throw at you from your mistaken action. Those things that you still tend to do that would be called 'sin' by the average conceited Christian will burn at your judgment seat of Christ. See I Corinthians 3:9-15 - 1Co 3:11, ¶ For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ. Now if any man build upon this foundation gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, stubble; Every man's work shall be made manifest: for the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is. If any man's work abide which he hath built thereupon, he shall receive a reward. If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: but he himself shall be saved; yet so as by fire. When Christ finally appears in Revelation 19, you will be holy, blameless and without shame. I Thessalonians 5:23 - And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. You can also sit down anytime, even on your final deathbed, sickness, frightening times, joy, peace, etc. and open your KJB and be comforted - Romans 15:4, For whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning, that we through patience and comfort of the scriptures might have hope as you are truly are face to face with the Risen Saviour because He speaks to you through those scriptures and you speak to him with prayer and thoughts! Hebrews 4:12,13, For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart. Neither is there any creature that is not manifest in his sight: but all things are naked and opened unto the eyes of him with whom we have to do. This is completely foreign to a modern Christian today.

Personal salvation, not national salvation II Timothy 3:15 And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. Gal 4:7 - Wherefore thou art no more a servant, but a son; and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ. In fact, even as a child before parents, school, churches and pastors today destroyed that simple faith that children have that faith... II Tim 3:15 And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. Because that which may be known of God is manifest in them; for God hath shewed it unto them. Rom 1:20,21 For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse: Because that, when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.

77. Understand true rightly dividing the word of truth for one's understanding of the past, present and future doctrine. It also clears doctrinal confusion that exists today with all the different denominational 'ways' taught for personal salvation. Yes - All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: HOWEVER, it must all be applied according to the various dispensations. ALL doctrine, etc. does not ALL apply to us ALL today! If it all did, you would be building a boat, trying to follow the OT Jewish law and promises, or the

The entire King James Bible is FOR us, but only parts are TO certain people. Genesis to Revelation is OT Jewish History; Gospels and Acts 1-8 were given to the JEWS then and ONLY to the Jews; Acts 9-28 – Transition from Jews to Gentiles; Romans to Philemon to Gentiles ONLY; Hebrews to Jude – Tribulation Jews.

beatitudes, or Paul, Peter, James and John in their sailboat... even Revelation.

Read it Genesis to Revelation but apply only Paul's books! If you do, you will see that you already are approved unto God and have nothing of which to be ashamed, which by the way, is what all these goodnesses of God will point out. You can only understand the goodness of God by following Paul and not trying to mix and confuse Paul's wonderful doctrine with the 'apostolic law' from the Gospels that was to the Jews ONLY; Paul's books are to the Gentiles ONLY.

78. Conspiracy to Hate Paul still exists today. By wrongly dividing, which God calls their words good words and fair speeches and profane and vain babblings, pastors to this day refuse to teach Paul's gospel from a King James Bible in their churches. As a result, their congregations are learning Jewish doctrine which is preparing their people for the coming Tribulation doctrine. That also means those people will miss the cutting away of the Gentile nation (Rom 11:22) meaning that they will still be here worshipping Satan as the antichrist with all kinds of music (Dan 3:3,5,10,15) which is what they are unknowingly being prepared for during their church services today! Act 23:12,13 And when it was day, certain of the Jews banded together, and bound themselves under a curse, saying that they would neither eat nor drink till they had killed Paul. And they were more than forty which had made this conspiracy. It continues to exist to this day!

- 79. A Gospel Not After Man Gal 1:10-12 For do I now persuade men, or God? or do I seek to please men? for if I yet pleased men, I should not be the servant of Christ. But I certify you, brethren, that the gospel which was preached of me is not after man. For I neither received it of man, neither was I taught it, but by the revelation of Jesus Christ. Paul's gospel is directly from the risen Christ Himself to Paul! The gospel in the churches today as well as now in the media is all about man's own faith and is geared after and written by man humanism. II Corinthians 2:17 For we are not as many, which corrupt the word of God: but as of sincerity, but as of God, in the sight of God speak we in Christ.
- **80. Profane and Vain Babbling Prayers** are Jewish prayers that pastors and authors encourage people to repeat today in their desire for God to 'fix' everything that is going wrong in their lives as well as the world! However, these are not 'to us' so they mean nothing to us (*Gentiles*) today and of course, they mean nothing to God either. So, they actually produce either (1) NOTHING, or (2) Satan pretends to answer them to make the prayer think he is getting answers to these Old Testament Jewish prayers and all that does is promoting more false religion of 'magnificence and spiritual fraud!
- Some of these empty and vain profane babbling prayers are: The Lord's Prayer (Matthew 6:9), Hannah's prayer (1 Samuel 2:1-10); Prayer of Jabez (1 Chronicles 4:10); Hezekiah's Prayer (2 Kings 19:15-19); Solomon's Prayer for Wisdom (1 Kings 3:7-9) and Dedication of the Temple (people use that for God to 'bless' their new house) (1 Kings 8:22-53) David's Prayers; Jonah's Prayer (Jonah 2:1-9); 2 Chron. 7:14 This is one that people pray as they get people to seek God's face hoping God will heal the land. These are all false prayers that create deceptive religions and denominations but also discourage people about the truth of God and prayer.

81. You learn who the 'children of disobedience' really are and are not. Modern bible versions say that the wrath of God will fall upon those who are disobedient, and they stress the word 'obedient.' That is a gross yet typical translation of nonsense with eternally damning results. According to a KJB, the wrath of God will come upon the children of disobedience (Eph 3:6; Col 5:6) but the children of disobedience are the ones dupped by vain words and are children of Satan – the lost people, no matter good or religious they are. Eph 2:2 Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience.

The wrath of God is NOT going to come upon a Christian who is 'disobedient' because a truly saved / quickened Christian is dead to sin and dead unto the law. His had 'works' are not imputed to him and those had works will burn at his

His bad 'works' are not imputed to him and those bad works will burn at his judgment seat of Christ. There is NO threat of God's wrath, also called the severity of God! That is the joy of truthfully taught 'Christianity' – and that is something that exists only as a rarity these days. Christianity today is simply preparing people for the coming of the antichrist – Satan. I Peter 5:8; Revelation 12; II Thessalonians 2:1-12.

This is just more proof that today's preachers using their modern bible versions reject the grace of God that Paul preaches and tell their people that they must walk an obedient walk to be blessed, or else they receive the severity of God.

That is why God says those preachers are evil men and seducers shall wax worse and worse, deceiving, and being deceived. God also says they are... proud, knowing nothing, but doting about questions and strifes of words, whereof cometh envy, strife, railings, evil surmisings, Perverse disputings of men of corrupt minds, and destitute of the truth, supposing that gain is godliness: which is why He also tells you and me... from such withdraw thyself.

82. Know about the coming famine! Amos 8:11-13 Behold, the days come, saith the Lord GOD, that I will send a famine in the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the words of the LORD: And they shall wander from sea to sea, and from the north even to the east, they shall run to and fro to seek the word of the LORD, and shall not find it. (try and find a King James 1611 Bible today)

83a. We get to say 'Good-bye' to Jesus' Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5.6) ...

The Sermon on the mount, like everything else preached today, is a sermon of profane and vain babblings. There are even things in that sermon / 'law' to the Jews that we can't even do today, nor do they even get preached. If the preacher is going to preach that sermon, then he should preach it all, not just portions. See the following examples:

- 5:9 being a peacekeeper makes you a child of God (see where people get this today!)?
- 5:18 the crucified and then risen Saviour actually fulfilled the law, so this verse alone makes the Sermon on the Mount AND all the gospels null and void for application. - 5:29 must pluck out your eye if you see something that causes you to 'sin?'
- 5:30 must cut off your hand if you do something with it that causes you to 'sin?'
- 5:32 divorced and she remarried made her commit adultery?
- 5:34 can't go back on your verbal promise / oath, etc.?
- 5:39 turn your other cheek?
- 5:40 if you are being sued, you must give them even more?
- 5:45 love your enemy to be a child of God?
- 5:48 be as perfect as God is?
- **6:9** if you don't forgive others, you will not receive forgiveness, either?
- **6:17** been fasting successfully?
- **6:24** serving two masters?
- 6:25 worried about your provisions ye of little faith? (there are more NOT TODAY!)

83b. ... and say hello to Paul's sermon on Mars' Hill – Acts 17:18-34

Paul preaches a sermon to people who are 'doing devotions' but know nothing about the living God. He calls them ignorant and superstitious. They think their worship is pleasing to God. Paul explains to them why they can do nothing to worship because they are not worthy. To make matters worse, some mocked Paul for what he was trying to teach them about the risen Christ but others were wanted to hear more of what Paul had to say. Read it all Acts 17:18-34. It fits the modern Christian scene today exactly!

Acts 17:22-28 Then Paul stood in the midst of Mars' hill, and said, Ye men of Athens, I perceive that in all things ye are too superstitious. For as I passed by, and beheld your devotions, I found an altar with this inscription, TO THE UNKNOWN GOD. Whom therefore ye ignorantly worship, him declare I unto you. God that made the world and all things therein, seeing that he is Lord of heaven and earth, dwelleth not in temples made with hands; Neither is worshipped with men's hands, as though he needed any thing, seeing he giveth to all life, and breath, and all things And hath made of one blood all nations of men for to dwell on all the face of the earth, and hath determined the times before appointed, and the bounds of their habitation; That they should seek the Lord, if haply they might feel after him, and find him, though he be not far from every one of us: For in him we live, and move, and have our being; as certain also of your own poets have said, For we are also his offspring.

84. Who and what are we not to be ashamed today! We are not to be ashamed of Jesus Christ as He is our Saviour. The entire testimony of Jesus Christ AND Paul: II Tim 1:8 - Be not thou therefore ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me his prisoner: but be thou partaker of the afflictions of the gospel according to the power of God; Ourself: II Tim 2:15 - Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth. Rom 9:33 - As it is written, Behold, I lay in Sion a stumblingstone and rock of offence: and whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed. Rom 10:11 - For the scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed. Rom 1:16 Paul's teachings of the risen Jesus Christ: For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.

85. Learn Satan's plan from the beginning and ends in Rev 19.

Isa 14:12-17, How art thou fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! how art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations! For thou hast said in thine heart, I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God: I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north: I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High.

Yet thou shalt be brought down to hell, to the sides of the pit. They that see thee shall narrowly look upon thee, and consider thee, saying, Is this the man that made the earth to tremble, that did shake kingdoms; That made the world as a wilderness, and destroyed the cities thereof; that opened not the house of his prisoners? Eze 28:13-19, Thou hast been in Eden the garden of God; every precious stone was thy covering, the sardius, topaz, and the diamond, the beryl, the onyx, and the jasper, the sapphire, the emerald, and the carbuncle, and gold: the workmanship of thy tabrets and of thy pipes was prepared in thee in the day that thou wast created. Thou art the anointed cherub that covereth; and I have set thee so: thou wast upon the holy mountain of God; thou hast walked up and down in the midst of the stones of fire. Thou wast perfect in thy ways from the day that thou wast created, till iniquity was found in thee. By the multitude of thy merchandise they have filled the midst of thee with violence, and thou hast sinned: therefore I will cast thee as profane out of the mountain of God: and I will destroy thee, O covering cherub, from the midst of the stones of fire. Thine heart was lifted up because of thy beauty, thou hast corrupted thy wisdom by reason of thy brightness: I will cast thee to the ground, I will lay thee before kings, that they may behold thee. Thou hast defiled thy sanctuaries by the multitude of thine iniquities, by the iniquity of thy traffick; therefore will I bring forth a fire from the midst of thee, it shall devour thee, and I will bring thee to ashes upon the earth in the sight of all them that behold thee. All they that know thee among the people shall be astonished at thee: thou shalt be a terror, and never shalt thou be any more.

86. What is the difference between the 'Great Commission' and the 'Greater Commission?' The great commission is based on the teachings that Jesus gave to the Jews only AFTER His resurrection. The Jews still hadn't come

to the belief that He was the son of God and that He had just risen from the dead. Jesus dropped in on the 'eleven,' upbraided them for their unbelief and hardness of heart, then gave them their commission: Mark 16:12-20 After that he appeared in another form unto two of them, as they walked, and went into the country. And they went and told it unto the residue: neither believed they them. Afterward he appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and upbraided them with their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they believed not them which had seen him after he was risen. And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover. So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, he was received up into heaven, and sat on the right hand of God. And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following. Amen. This involved miracles, signs and wonders because Jews wanted signs. When that failed, Christ went to Peter and Stephen and offered one more opportunity for Him to return to the Jews Acts 1-8. Unfortunately for the Jews, they rejected Peter's sermon of water baptism and the new church in Acts 2:14-47 and in Acts 6:5-15: 7:1-60, the Jews killed Stephen. After all that, Christ Himself went to a man named Saul, (soon called Paul), and gave him his commission to go to the Gentiles in all the earth: Acts 13:46,47

Then Paul and Barnabas waxed bold, and said, It was necessary that the word of God should first have been spoken to you: but seeing ye put it from you, and judge yourselves unworthy of everlasting life, lo, we turn to the Gentiles. For so hath the Lord commanded us, saying, I have set thee to be a light of the Gentiles, that thou shouldest be for salvation unto the ends of the earth. No signs, etc. I call Paul's commission the "Greater Commission" to the Gentiles compared to Peters "Great Commission" to the Jews. Pastors mistakenly claim the "Great Commission" now.

87. Learn the truth of and understand the great supper of God.

Rev 19:17-21. And I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the fowls that fly in the midst of heaven,

Come and gather yourselves together unto the supper of the great God;

and the flesh of mighty men, and the flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them,

And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season.

89. After those thousand years, then what? Revelation 20:7-10

And when the thousand years are expired,
Satan shall be loosed out of his prison,
And shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth,
Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle:
the number of whom is as the sand of the sea.

And they went up on the breadth of the earth,
and compassed the camp of the saints about, and the beloved city:
and fire came down from God out of heaven, and devoured them.

And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone,
where the beast and the false prophet are,
and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.
