The Continual Growth Process Within the Body of Christ - Eph 4:11-16

A true Christian life is **not** about struggling to be 'blessed' of God pretending to walk an 'obedient daily life' with your pastor's 'good words and fair speeches' scratching your 'itching ears' by trying to follow the 'apostolic doctrine' as taught by Peter and the apostle which was only meant for the 'Jews,' all the while living under the daily fear of the 'severity of God' with you pretending to 'be like Christ,' and while at your favorite church, falsely worshipping your unknown God' with 'all kinds of music' during today's new 'global awakening,' believing you are anointed by God having no more need to study the KJB. **Bondage!**

And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ: Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ: That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive; But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ: From whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplieth, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, maketh increase of the body unto the edifying of itself in love.

17-19 - This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that ye henceforth walk not as other Gentiles walk, in the vanity of their mind, Having the understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart: Who being past feeling have given themselves over unto lasciviousness, to work all uncleanness with greediness.

20-24 - But ye have not so learned Christ; If so be that ye have heard him, and have been taught by him, as the truth is in Jesus: That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; And be renewed in the spirit of your mind; And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.

This all comes from following the risen and living Christ presented to us Gentiles today according to Paul, the only apostle to the Gentiles, as found only in a King James Bible transitioning us through **Acts 9-28** and then to us Gentiles through **Romans** to **Philemon** only, while teaching us the *Kingdom of God* and the *Goodness of God*, offering us a personal salvation by faith in Christ while at the same time receiving the faith of Jesus Christ by believing His *inspired, pure, preserved* and *that which is perfect rightly divided word of truth*, while **withdrawing from** the pulpit lies and false worship (Global Awakening) of today as found in all the modern doctrinally corrupt bibles, according to *the evil men and seducers who continue to wax worse and worse, deceiving and being deceived; men who Jesus says are proud, knowing nothing, but dotting about questions and strifes of words, whereof cometh envy, strife, railings, evil surmisings, perverse disputings of men of corrupt minds, and destitute of the truth, supposing that gain is godliness:* **Galatians 1:1-24; Romans 2:4; Romans 16:25; Galatians 2:7,8; Romans 14:17; II Timothy 3:13; Titus 2:1-15; Ephesians 3:1-21; Romans 5-8; 13:47**

You Must Be Seeking God's Direction and Be Willing to Grow!

In meekness instructing those that oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the truth; And that they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will. II Timothy 2:24-26

If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God. Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth. For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God. Colossians 3:1

Epaphras, who is one of you, a servant of Christ, saluteth you, always labouring fervently for you in prayers, that ye may stand perfect and complete in all the will of God. Colossians 4:12

For they themselves shew of us what manner of entering in we had unto you, and how ye turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God; And to wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead, even Jesus, which delivered us from the wrath to come. I Thessalonians 1:9,10

When the "NEW MAN" is put on, changes will be made as the Christian grows.

(Ephesians 4:17-32; Isaiah 61:10; Acts 26:18)

1. The Christian should try to **put away lying** (vs. 25). The verse is self-explanatory (Romans 12:5). We are members of the same body. The word *neighbour* refers to another Christian in Christ. It is extremely difficult to be honest at ALL TIMES. The Christian who will not admit this is somewhat of a liar himself.
2. The Christian should **speak... the truth** (vs. 25).
3. **Be ye angry, and sin not...** (vs. 26). The Christian can get angry at times (Titus 1:13; II Corinthians 13:2), but he is not to "serve sin" when he gets angry as it gives place to the devil. Jesus was angry at nothing but sin and was angry at no one but the religious leaders of the Ecumenical council of His day.
4. **...let not the sun go down upon your wrath** (vs. 26). Twelve hours is long enough to be mad at anybody. If you go on with it, you will lose sleep and if you die in your sleep, you will have to deal with it again at the Judgment Seat of Christ (I Tim 5:25).
5. **Neither give place to the devil** (vs. 27). You will do this if you keep on nursing grudges (cf. II Corinthians 2:10-11).
6. **Let him that stole steal no more...** (vs. 28).
7. **Let him labour, working with his hands ... that he may have to give...** (vs. 28). The Bible encourages men to work (II Thessalonians 3:10). The real Christian goes beyond the requirements of providing for his own house; he works so that he may have to give to him that needeth (vs. 28).
- 8,9. The eighth admonition is against **corrupt communication** (vs. 29). The positive half of the verse, encourages that **which is good ... that it may minister grace unto the hearers**. While corrupt communication includes the passing on of rumors, the inventing of slander, the dirty joke, the "off color joke" (see 5:3-4), and any language that is foul, filthy, rude, or obscene, we know today that it includes the media today. "Good words and fair speeches" do not remedy the problem because "good words and fair speeches" (Romans 16:18) are actually characteristic of the most corrupt communicators. Also see Acts 24:16; II Timothy 2:23-26 about being offensive and striving with those who oppose themselves and are caught up in Satan's snares - they must get out themselves. The AV 1611 has never been guilty of a corrupt communication or of a corrupt text; however, the *scholars* who have lied to their followers and 'customers' are professional liars & corrupters and have deceived millions.
10. The tenth warning is "grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption" (vs. 30; cf. 1:13-14). He can be grieved and quenched. I Thess 5:19. He can be resisted (Acts 7:51). Fortunately, the Christian is sealed unto the Day of Redemption (Ephesians 1:13, 4:30). The Holy Spirit is grieved with foolish talking and jesting, sinning and uncleanness, all unrighteousness, lying, loating, exaggerating, self-pity, lack of concern, lack of gratitude, lack of fruit (see Galatians 5:22), grumbling, murmuring, stinginess, jealousy, false accusations, lack of faith, refusal to testify, indifference to the Bible, perversion of the truth, failure to praise God, and worrying., etc.

HOLY BIBLE

"The day of redemption" is the "day of Christ" (see II Corinthians 1:22; I Corinthians 1:8; 4:5; II Timothy 4:8; II Thessalonians 2:2).

A sincere and growing Christian should also try to reject

11. Bitterness; 12. Wrath; 13. Anger; 14. Clamour
15. Evil speaking; 16. All malice

Anger is cruel, wrath is outrageous (Proverbs 27:4), bitterness and clamour are works of the flesh still in us (Ephesians 4:31, Rom 7), evil speaking is a violation of Ephesians 4:29, and malice is part of the old life (Titus 3:3). Malice is an attitude, clamour is the result of anger and wrath. Evil speaking can cause bitterness. Bitterness is a stimulant to wrath and anger. More light on these terms is found in Acts 8:23; Rom 3:14; 12:5; I Tim 6:4; Col. 3:8).

17. Be ye kind; 18. Tenderhearted; 19. Forgiving one another

Forgiveness should be the easiest thing to do but is often the hardest. Personal hurts and personal injuries are to be overlooked, forgotten, put away, or ignored altogether (Colossians 3:13).

The tendency to retaliate where one has been slandered or reviled is part of the old humus of human nature. The passage is not referring to being kind towards critics who hate and attack God's word (note Titus 1:10-12; I Timothy 1:20), but it is a personal reference to personal dealings. II Timothy 2:24-26

Today's Christians are often very unkind to one another; they are not in the least tenderhearted in the middle of church splits, doctrinal controversies, and business meetings. The ones who talk the most about courtesy, love, politeness, and soft words are usually the most vicious and venomous in an out-and-out showdown.

Forgiving one another should come easy in view of the fact that...God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you Eph 4:32.

Final warning with commentary: Unfortunately, many Christians were told they were saved in their early years when they weren't even lost or are scripturally ignorant adults claiming various false teachings such as 'bom-againism,' praying certain prayers, asking Jesus into their hearts, giving their lives over to Jesus, revival through worship, etc. from modern bibles and evil seducing pastors with good words and fair speeches.

Pastors have led them to 'another Jesus,' received 'another spirit' and have accepted another 'gospel.' (II Cor 11:1-4) and do not follow Paul's gospel (Gal 1:1-16, Romans 2:16). They have been falsely taught that they have been anointed by the Holy Spirit (John 14, I John 2:27) thus making it near impossible to convince them that the word of truth must be rightly divided (II Tim 2:15,16) showing the different teachings to OT Jews and to Gentiles today as only found a King James Bible and are NOT found in any modern bible today.

As a result, Christians have become extremely arrogant and conceited (Romans 11:25) and are worship-led people who judged others by believing that 'gain is godliness' (I Tim 6:5). Sadly, they fear the severity of God and pass that type of fear onto others. They completely miss out on the Goodness of God (Romans 2:4) and the simplicity of the teachings of the RISEN Saviour and know nothing of the joy of true Christianity while they continue to falsely worship their unknown God (Acts 17:23) with all kinds of music (Dan 3:5).

Modern Christians are the most arrogant 'blessed' and 'judgmental' people and are vicious foes of truthful Biblical KJB teaching; they are totally deceived as a result of the total blindness created by the religions of modern corrupt bibles and evil seducing pastors with their good words and fair speeches deceiving the hearts of the simple. (Rom 16:18) rejecting sound doctrine. (II Tim 4:2-4).

The Inspired, God-breathed Holy Scriptures, the Word of truth,
the Gospel of Our Salvation, the Words of the Lord, the WORD OF GOD
inspirationally preserved, inerrant and written for Gentiles today as
"That which is perfect" - came in 1611.

When *'that which is perfect'* came, that which was 'in part' was 'done away.
Now, as Gentiles, we can *put away childish things* and as a church of God
(saved, quickened Gentile), we can *know even as also I am known*.
