Paul's 'Experience' on the Road to Damascus, Ananias, Jews for First Time and Meets King Agrippa

Acts 9:1-22

And Saul, yet breathing out threatenings and slaughter against the disciples of the Lord, went unto the high priest, And desired of him letters to Damascus to the synagogues, that if he found any of this way, whether they were men or women, he might bring them bound unto Jerusalem. And as he journeyed, he came near Damascus: and suddenly there shined round about him a light from heaven: And he fell to the earth, and heard a voice saying unto him, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me? And he said, Who art thou, Lord? And the Lord said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest: it is hard for thee to kick against the pricks. And he trembling and astonished said, Lord, what wilt thou have me to do? And the Lord said unto him, Arise, and go into the city, and it shall be told thee what thou must do. And the men which journeyed with him stood speechless, hearing a voice, but seeing no man. And Saul arose from the earth; and when his eyes were opened, he saw no man: but they led him by the hand, and brought him into Damascus. And he was three days without sight, and neither did eat nor drink.

And there was a certain disciple at Damascus, named Ananias; and to him said the Lord in a vision, Ananias. And he said, Behold, I am here, Lord. And the Lord said unto him, Arise, and go into the street which is called Straight, and enquire in the house of Judas for one called Saul, of Tarsus: for, behold, he prayeth, And hath seen in a vision a man named Ananias coming in, and putting his hand on him, that he might receive his sight. Then Ananias answered, Lord, I have heard by many of this man, how much evil he hath done to thy saints at Jerusalem: And here he hath authority from the chief priests to bind all that call on thy name. But the Lord said unto him, Go thy way: for he is a chosen vessel unto me, to bear my name before the Gentiles, and kings, and the children of Israel: For I will shew him how great things he must suffer for my name's sake. And Ananias went his way, and entered into the house; and putting his hands on him said, Brother Saul, the Lord, even Jesus, that appeared unto thee in the way as thou camest, hath sent me, that thou mightest receive thy sight, and be filled with the Holy Ghost. And immediately there fell from his eyes as it had been scales: and he received sight forthwith, and arose, and was baptized.

And when he had received meat, he was strengthened. Then was Saul certain days with the disciples which were at Damascus. And straightway he preached Christ in the synagogues, that he is the Son of God. But all that heard him were amazed, and said; Is not this he that destroyed them which called on this name in Jerusalem, and came hither for that intent, that he might bring them bound unto the chief priests? But Saul increased the more in strength, and confounded the Jews which dwelt at Damascus, proving that this is very Christ.

Acts 26:1,2 and **14-18** - *Then Agrippa said unto Paul, Thou art permitted to speak for thyself. Then Paul stretched forth the hand, and answered for himself: I think myself happy, king Agrippa, because I shall answer for myself this day before thee touching all the things whereof I am accused of the Jews: ... **14-18** - And when we were all fallen to the earth, I heard a voice speaking unto me, and saying in the Hebrew tongue, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me? it is hard for thee to kick against the pricks. And I said, Who art thou, Lord? And he said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest. But rise, and stand upon thy feet: for I have appeared unto thee for this purpose, to make thee a minister and a witness both of these things which thou hast seen, and of those things in the which I will appear unto thee; Delivering thee from the people, and from the Gentiles, unto whom now I send thee, To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.*

During Today's "Dispensation of the Grace of God," We are to Learn Of and Follow the Risen Christ Through Paul Because We Know: THE RISEN CHRIST SPOKE DIRECTLY TO PAUL.

*Testifying both to the Jews, and also to the Greeks, repentance toward God, and faith toward our Lord Jesus Christ...
But none of these things move me, neither count I my life dear unto myself, so that I might finish my course with joy,
and the ministry, which I have received of the Lord Jesus, to testify the gospel of the grace of God. Act 20:21,24*

*But I certify you, brethren, that the gospel which was preached of me is not after man.
For I neither received it of man, neither was I taught it, but by the revelation of Jesus Christ. Galatians 1:11,12*

And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures:

And that he was seen of Cephas, then of the twelve:

After that, he was seen of above five hundred brethren at once; of whom the greater part remain unto this present, but some are fallen asleep.

After that, he was seen of James; then of all the apostles.

And last of all he was seen of me also, as of one born out of due time.

For I am the least of the apostles, that am not meet to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God.

*But by the grace of God I am what I am: and his grace which was bestowed upon me was not in vain;
but I laboured more abundantly than they all: yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me. I Corinthians 15:4-10*

It is not expedient for me doubtless to glory. I will come to visions and revelations of the Lord. I knew a man in Christ above fourteen years ago, (whether in the body, I cannot tell; or whether out of the body, I cannot tell: God knoweth;) such an one caught up to the third heaven. And I knew such a man, (whether in the body, or out of the body, I cannot tell: God knoweth;) How that he was caught up into paradise, and heard unspeakable words, which it is not lawful for a man to utter. Of such an one will I glory: yet of myself I will not glory, but in mine infirmities. For though I would desire to glory, I shall not be a fool; for I will say the truth: but now I forbear, lest any man should think of me above that which he seeth me to be, or that he heareth of me. II Corinthians 12:1-6

*For this cause I Paul, the prisoner of Jesus Christ for you Gentiles, If ye have heard of the dispensation of the grace of God which is given me to you-ward:
How that by revelation he made known unto me the mystery; (as I wrote afore in few words, Whereby, when ye read, ye may understand my knowledge in the
mystery of Christ) Which in other ages was not made known unto the sons of men, as it is now revealed unto his holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit;*

That the Gentiles should be fellowheirs, and of the same body, and partakers of his promise in Christ by the gospel:

Whereof I was made a minister, according to the gift of the grace of God given unto me by the effectual working of his power. Ephesians 3:1-7

*But contrariwise, when they saw that the gospel of the uncircumcision was committed unto me,
as the gospel of the circumcision was unto Peter;
(For he that wrought effectually in Peter to the apostleship of the circumcision,
the same was mighty in me toward the Gentiles:),
And when James, Cephas, and John, who seemed to be pillars, perceived the grace that was given unto me,
they gave to me and Barnabas the right hands of fellowship;
that we should go unto the heathen, and they unto the circumcision. Galatians 2:7-9*

First, Christ “followed” them! (Jews) (not imitate...)

**I Corinthians 10:4 - *And did all drink the same spiritual drink:
for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and that Rock was Christ.***

Then He asked them (Jews) to "follow" Him! (not imitate)

**Matthew 19:21 - *Jesus said unto him, If thou wilt be perfect, go and sell that thou hast, and give to the poor,
and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come and follow me.***

Today we (Gentiles) are to "follow" Paul as he “follows” the RISEN Christ’s teachings! (not imitate)

I Corinthians 11:1 - *Be ye followers of me, even as I also am of Christ.*

**Also see: Romans 11:13,14; 15:15,16; I Corinthians 3:10; 4:16; Philippians 3:17; 4:9;
I Thessalonians 1:5,6; 4:1,2; II Thessalonians 3:7-9; I Timothy 1:15,16; II Timothy 2:7; 4:16,17.**

Yes, someday, we all will follow Christ directly: (no imitations)

**Ephesians 2:14 - *For he is our peace, who hath made both one,
and hath broken down the middle wall of partition between us;***

**Revelation 19:14 - *And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses,
clothed in fine linen, white and clean.***

Galatians

This is the Christ That Paul Preaches.

Ephesians

1:1 He died but was & still is raised from the dead.

1:4 He gave himself for our sins. He did (spiritually) and will (physically) deliver us from this present evil world!

1:10 He is the one to please!

2:4; 5:1 He is our liberty – He literally makes us free!

2:20 He is the one living in us now /the one who loved & loves me - who gave himself for me!

3:1 He was crucified!

4:5 He redeemed us from under the law!

5:6 In his faith availeth everything!

6:15 In Him availeth a new creature (**II Cor 5:17**)

6:16 Our peace is based on our walk in Him, through Paul!

6:17 We bear his marks on us and in our life!

1:3 He blesses us with all spiritual blessings!

1:5 He made our adoption possible!

1:6 He made us accepted in the beloved! (**Romans 11:28**)

1:7 He gives us redemption through his blood and He forgives all our sins, past – present - future!

1:8 He abounds his wisdom and prudence toward us!

1:9 He makes known to us the mystery of his will!

1:11,14 He gives to us & seals the earnest of his inheritance for now...

1:17 He gives us the spirit of wisdom reveals Himself!

1:18 He enlightens our sight, shows us the hope of God's calling, He shows us riches of his inheritance!

1:19 He shows us the exceeding greatness of his power!

2:1,5 He quickens from being dead in trespasses & sins!

2:6 He raised us up together, and made it so we can sit together in heavenly places IN Him!

2:7 He shews the exceeding riches of God's grace in his kindness toward us through Himself!

- 2:12** He gives us hope now and gives us God!
- 2:13** He makes us nigh to God!
- 2:14** He brings us together with the Jews!
- 2:15-17** He abolished the enmity between us and God
- 2:18** He gives us access unto the Father
- 2:19** He makes us fellow citizens with God's household!
- 2:20** He builds us up on a solid foundation!
- 3:9-12** He gives us access to the heavenly wisdom of God in a bold & confident manner because of His faith!
- 3:16** He strengthens us by his Spirit!
- 3:17-19** He dwells in our hearts by faith - roots and grounds us in His love - makes us good ground!
- 3:20** He is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, etc.!
- 4:11** He gives some, apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors & teachers, etc.!
- 4:12** He works on perfecting us and edifying us - as well as showing us the true work of the ministry today!

- 4:20** He takes away our opinions / replaces them with His mind through His words in the KJB today!
- 4:24** He is the new man we are to put on - created in righteousness and true holiness!
- 5:2** He gave himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling savour!
- 5:14** He wakes us up from the dead by turning our light on!
- 6:10-18** He 'is' our armour – 'all' of our armour!

Philippians

- 1:6** He will perform the good work he began in us until He comes back - we can be sure of that!
- 2:6** He is equal with God!
- 2:7** He made himself of no reputation!
- 2:7** He took upon him the form of a servant, was made in the likeness of men! (see **Romans 6:5**)
- 2:8** He humbled himself and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross!
- 2:9** He is and was highly exalted by God!

Philippians

This is the Christ That Paul Preaches.

- 2:9** His name is above every name! (see **Psalm 138:2**)
- 2:10** He will be bowed down-to by everything/everyone!
- 2:11** Everyone will confess to Him that He is Lord!
- 3:9** We will be found in HIS righteousness!

Colossians

- 1:11** We are strengthened with all his might unto all patience and longsuffering with joyfulness!
- 1:13** He delivered us from the power of darkness!
- 1:13** He translated us into His spiritual kingdom!
- 1:14** He redeemed us through his blood - even the forgiveness of sins!
- 1:15** His image is of the invisible God Himself!
- 1:16** By him, for him, were all things created!
- 1:17** He is before all things and by him all things consist!
- 1:18** He is the head of the body, the church!
- 1:19** In him, all fulness dwells!

- 1:20** He made peace for us through the blood of his cross!
- 1:20,21** He reconciled all things unto himself!
- 1:22** He will eventually present us holy and unblameable and unproveable in the sight of God!
- 2:3** ...all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge!
- 2:11** He put off the body of sins of our flesh!
- 2:12** We are buried with Him and have risen with him!
- 2:13** He quickened us together with him, having forgiven us all trespasses!
- 3:4** He will have us appear with him in glory!
- 3:12** He makes us increase and abound in love toward one another and toward all men!
- 3:13** He stablishes our hearts unblameable in holiness before God at His coming!

II Thessalonians

This is the Christ That Paul Preaches.

Titus

1:7-10 He will take care of all necessary vengeance!

2:16 He gives everlasting consolation and good hope!

3:3 He stablishes us and keeps us from evil!

I Timothy

1:14 His grace is abundant with faith and love!

2:6 He gave himself a ransom for all!

6:15 He is the blessed and ONLY Potentate, the King of kings, and Lord of lords!

6:16 He hath immortality, dwelling in the light which no man can approach unto, seen, can see, etc.

6:16 He is to whom be honour and power everlasting!

II Timothy

1:10 He abolished death!

1:10 He brought life and immortality to light!

2:1 He gives us strength through his grace!

2:8 He was raised from the dead!

1:3 He manifests His words to us through preaching of Paul and today, through the KJB — “*Beyond Paul!*”

2:13 He is our blessed hope!

2:14 He is the One who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.

3:6 He shed on us abundantly the washing and renewing of the Holy Ghost!

3:7 He justified us by his grace that we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life!

Philemon

1:3 He is from whom grace and peace has come!

1:6 He is from whom every good thing is in!

Jesus Warned the Jews

Matthew 24:24

For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect.

Through Paul, Christ Warns Us About Following ‘Another Jesus,’ ‘Another Spirit’ and ‘Another Gospel.’

For I am jealous over you with godly jealousy: for I have espoused you to one husband, that I may present you as a chaste virgin to Christ.

But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent beguiled Eve through his subtilty, so your minds should be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ.

*For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him. **II Corinthians 11:2-4***

I marvel that ye are so soon removed from him that called you into the grace of Christ unto another gospel: Which is not another; but there be some that trouble you, and would pervert the gospel of Christ.

But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed.

As we said before, so say I now again,

*If any man preach any other gospel unto you than that ye have received, let him be accursed. **Galatians 1:6-9***

God’s Last Warning Today – Time is Running Out for the Gentile Nation

Romans 11:22, Behold therefore the goodness and severity of God:
*on them which fell, severity; but toward thee, goodness, if thou continue in his goodness:
otherwise thou also shalt be cut off.*

Because of the “goodness of God” that is taught only by Paul and found only in a King James 1611 Bible, I do sincerely hope this video presentation Bible study has brought you to a new level of Biblical / Scriptural awareness and understanding.




However, during the ‘time of the great tribulation,’ the severity of God returns and the goodness of God ends... and this time of tribulation does appear to be coming sooner than later!
