Introduction

Confusing today?

The Bible seems so confusing to people today.

- They have been told it is!
 - They have been shown apparent confusion!
 - o They have been shown apparent contradictions (to the 'students')
- They have perceived the confusion and folly of Biblical teachings today!
 - o II Timothy 3:9 But they shall proceed no further: for their folly shall be manifest unto all men, as theirs also was.
- We have the Bible Believers who seem to be equally confused today!
 - They believe they can have this 'Godly understanding' without the Bible... an inner feeling, etc.
 - I Corinthians 2:12,13
 - Colossians 1:9
 - I Corinthians 13:8
- In his day, the Spirit would show them what Paul was teaching and through Paul, etc.
- But His word is NOT confusing nor was it ever meant to be!
- Psalm 119:116 Uphold me according unto thy word, that I may live: and let me not be ashamed of my hope.
- Psalm 119:130 The entrance of thy words giveth light; it giveth understanding unto the simple.

 - knowing dispensational application exposes error and false teachings, etc.
 - exposes the works of Satan/antichrist
- Perfect no more translating corrections / 'polishing,' etc.
- Inerrant without error
- Infallible incapable of error
- Inspired
 - I Thessalonians 2:13b ...ye received it not as the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God, which effectually worketh also in you that believe.
- Compare others, etc.!

Under the Gospel of the Kingdom, the Apostle Peter was chosen to be the chief of the twelve apostles. Matthew 16:19

him face-to-face in the flesh.

Matthew 4:18-20.

Peter was close enough to Jesus that Jesus gave to him the 'keys of the kingdom of heaven." **Matthew 16:19**

Peter was sought out by Satan himself. Luke 22:31,32

He seems to still have used him today!

- Peter is being used today to further the 'wrong' gospel to Gentiles.
- How could that be if Satan tried to use Peter to deny Christ, as he did?
- Matthew 16:21-23
- Luke 22:54-62

Paul even had to rebuke Peter for his misactions with the people.

• Galatians 2:14: But when I saw that they walked not uprightly according to the truth of the gospel, I said unto Peter before them all, If thou, being a Jew, livest after the manner of Gentiles, and not as do the Jews, why compellest thou the Gentiles to live as do the Jews?

Peter mentioned that Paul was hard to be understood.

II Peter 3:15.16

Peter's writings are written TO the people during the Tribulation.

- He teaches strict obedience to the law. faith and to follow Jesus.
- We can learn from the suffering verses that Peter wrote, but we don't have to fret the consequences that Peter also warned

Christ and Paul Acts 9:15

On the other hand, under the gospel of the grace of God, the Apostle Paul was chosen to be the Lord's chief representative.

The Lord appointed him personally, encountering Paul also met with Jesus Christ but this time, it was the Risen Christ that Paul had met - and more than once, as well.

Kingdom Church

Acts 2:42-47

During the Gospels, the 'church' was a synagogue, and Jesus preached & taught in them quite often and even on the Sabbath.

Then we see in Matthew 16:13-20 that Christ will Ephesians 5:23-32 build his church on what Peter believed, as it was taught by God, not by flesh & blood.

It makes sense that the church that Christ was going to be the head of during the Dispensation of Grace with Paul would not start until the death of Christ.

Hebrews 9:14-17.

Immediately after the resurrection, the church design is described in Acts 2:42-47. This is the church that Peter and the apostles were to 'build' as they were to go unto all the world with what Christians call the Great Commission with all the signs and healings, etc. following.

Church based on Apostles Doctrine:

Christ and the church is a great mystery!

Grace in a Dispensation Psalm 84:11

There was never a time when God did not exercise grace in dealing with His people.

Psalms 84:11 - For the LORD God is a sun and shield: the LORD will give grace and glory: no good thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly.

God has bestowed His grace in many specific instances and to accomplish certain goals in accordance with His plan and purpose.

Ezra 9:7-9 - And said, O my God, I am ashamed and blush to lift up my face to thee, my God: for our iniquities are increased over our head, and our trespass is grown up unto the heavens. Since the days of our fathers have we been in a great trespass unto this day; and for our iniquities have we, our kings, and our priests, been delivered into the hand of the kings of the lands, to the sword, to captivity, and to a spoil, and to confusion of face, as it is this day. And now for a little space grace hath been shewed from the LORD our God, to leave us a remnant to escape, and to give us a nail in his holy place, that our God may lighten our eyes, and give us a little reviving in our bondage. For we were bondmen; yet our God hath not forsaken us in our bondage, but hath extended mercy unto us in the sight of the kings of Persia, to give us a reviving, to set up the house of our God, and to repair the desolations thereof, and to give us a wall in Judah and in Jerusalem.

Proverbs 3:34 - Surely he scorneth the scorners: but he giveth grace unto the lowly.

Psalm 45:2 - Thou art fairer than the children of men: grace is poured into thy lips: therefore God hath blessed thee for ever.

The Dispensation of Grace

Ephesians 2:8,9

Today, instead of praying for and trying to live upright enough - approaching the throne, etc. for His grace, we live in the Dispensation of Grace.

Although salvation was always by grace through faith, there was, in past dispensations, an additional ingredient: certain works were required in order to prove genuine and sincere faith.

Habakkuk 2:4 - Behold, his soul which is lifted up is not upright in him: but the just shall live by his faith.

Note this statement by Jesus Christ as he sent out His apostles: "He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved."

See how different the salvation is today:

Ephesians 2:8,9 - For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast.

Romans 4:5 - But to him that worketh not, but believeth on him that justifieth the ungodly, his faith is counted for righteousness.

Ephesians 1:13,14 - In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise, Which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of his glory.

Grace Today

Ephesians 3:8 - Unto me, who am less than the least of all saints, is this grace given, that I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ;

II Thessalonians 2:16 - Now our Lord Jesus Christ himself, and God, even our Father, which hath loved us, and hath given us everlasting consolation and good hope through grace,

I Timothy 1:14 - And the grace of our Lord was exceeding abundant with faith and love which is in Christ Jesus.

Titus 2:11 - For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men,

Titus 3:7 - That being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life.

God's Promise to Israel

Genesis 12:1-3

Genesis 12:1-3 - Now the LORD had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee: And I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing: And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed.

But, because they were disobedient, Israel has been set aside and their promised kingdom is held in abeyance (The condition of being temporarily set aside).

Note:

Read Leviticus 26 for details of God's punishment to them if they ever chose to not hearken unto Him

- by choosing to not do all His commandments
- if they despise His statues
- if their soul abhorred His judgments.
- Then, look at what is going on in the world today... could it all be a preparation for the Tribulation to the Jews and we are to really have no part in it?
 - o II Timothy 2:4 No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of this life; that he may please him who hath chosen him to

God's Promise to the Body of Christ

Ephesians 1:12-14

Because Israel's future has been put on hold, God has ushered in a new dispensation with a different promise.

Israel's promise is earthly, but the promises to the present church, the Body of Christ, are heavenly.

- **Ephesians 3:1-12 -** The mystery now revealed...
- Ephesians 1:12-14 That we should be to the praise of his glory, who first trusted in Christ. In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise, Which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of his glory.
- Philippians 3:20,21 For our conversation is in heaven; from whence also we look for the Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ: Who shall change our vile body, that it may be fashioned like unto his glorious body, according to the working whereby he is able even to subdue all things unto himself.
- Ephesians 4:11-15 And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets;

be a soldier.

However, God never withdraws a commitment.

Though He has temporarily set the Israelites aside, even Paul the apostle wrote...

- Romans 11:1 Hath God cast away His people? God forbid. For I also am an Israelite, of the seed of Abraham, of the tribe of Benjamin.
- Galatians 3:17,18 And this I say, that the covenant, that was confirmed before God in Christ, the law, which was four hundred and thirty years after, cannot disannul that it should make the promise of none effect. For if the inheritance be of the law, it is no more of promise: but God gave it to Abraham by promise.
- Romans 11:26,27 And so all Israel shall be saved: as it is written, There shall come out of Sion the Deliverer, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob: For this is my covenant unto them, when I shall take away their sins.

Isaiah 54:7,8 - For a small moment have I forsaken thee; but with great mercies will I gather thee. In a little wrath I hid my face from thee for a moment; but with everlasting kindness will I have mercy on thee, saith the LORD thy Redeemer.

Future Covenant Coming

Hebrews 8:6-13 - But now hath he obtained a more excellent ministry, by how much also he is the mediator of a better covenant, which was established upon better promises. For if that first covenant had been faultless, then should no place have been sought for the second. For finding fault with them, he saith, Behold, the days come, saith the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah: Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; because they continued not in my covenant, and I regarded them not, saith the Lord. For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord; I will put my laws

The Law Before the Cross

Deuteronomy 4:5-8

Until the work of Christ was completed, people had lived under the law.

What and when God commanded, the people were to obey under threat of punishment.

Leviticus 26

Moses was the dispenser of God's commandments.

Deuteronomy 4:5-6 - Behold, I have taught you statutes and judgments, even as the LORD my God commanded me, that ye should do so in the land whither ye go to possess it. Keep therefore and do them; for this is your wisdom and your understanding in the sight of the nations, which shall hear all these statutes, and say, Surely this great nation is a wise and understanding people.

God had prophets teach and preach the law.

In fact, there are a number of verses that use the phrase, "the law and the prophets..."

- Matthew 7:12 Therefore all things whatsoever ye would that men should do to you, do ye even so to them: for this is the law and the prophets.
- Luke 1:70 As he spake by the mouth of his holy prophets, which

The Law After the Cross

Galatians 2:15,16

John 1:17 - For the law was given by Moses, but grace and truth came by Jesus Christ.

How different it still is today now that we are even past Jesus' time.

It has to be 'after' the cross that it all took affect!

- Hebrews 9:16,17 For where a testament is, there must also of necessity be the death of the testator.
- For a testament is of force after men are dead: otherwise it is of no strength at all while the testator liveth.

Our apostle declares that a man is justified without the deeds of the law. FAITH!

- See Romans 3:27,28 Where is boasting then? It is excluded. By what law? of works? Nay: but by the law of faith. Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the law.
- Compare that to the Old Testament who had to live by their own faith!
 - See Habakkuk 2:4 Behold, his soul which is lifted up is not upright in him: but the just shall live by his faith.

Dead to the law

- have been since the world began:
- Luke 16:31 And he said unto him, If they hear not Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded, though one rose from the dead.

Jesus came to fulfil the law!

- Matthew 5:17 Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil.
- Luke 18:31 Then he took unto him the twelve, and said unto them, Behold, we go up to Jerusalem, and all things that are written by the prophets concerning the Son of man shall be accomplished.
- Luke 24:25-27 Then he said unto them, O fools, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken: Ought not Christ to have suffered these things, and to enter into his glory? And beginning at Moses and all the prophets, he expounded unto them in all the scriptures the things concerning himself.

God exhorted:

Numbers 15:40,41 - That ye may remember, and do all my commandments, and be holy unto your God. I am the LORD your God, Faith in Christ gives us the Faith of Christ which brought you out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: I am the LORD your God.

When Solomon had finished building the temple, God admonished him:

II Chronicles 7:17-20 - And as for thee, if thou wilt walk before me, as David thy father walked, and do according to all that I have commanded thee, and shalt observe my statutes and my judgments; Then will I stablish the throne of thy kingdom, according as I have

- Romans 7:6-7 But now we are delivered from the law, that being dead wherein we were held; that we should serve in newness of spirit, and not in the oldness of the letter.
- What shall we say then? Is the law sin? God forbid. Nay, I had not known sin, but by the law: for I had not known lust, except the law had said, Thou shalt not covet.
- Romans 5:13 (For until the law sin was in the world: but sin is not imputed when there is no law.
- Romans 3:30,31 See it is one God, which shall justify the circumcision by faith, and uncircumcision through faith.
- Do we then make void the law through faith? God forbid: yea, we establish the law.
- Romans 3:20 Therefore by the deeds of the law there shall no flesh be justified in his sight: for by the law is the knowledge of sin.
- Romans 3:21,22 But now the righteousness of God without the law is manifested, being witnessed by the law and the prophets;
- Even the righteousness of God which is by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference:...

Mind vs flesh

Romans 7:25 - I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord. So then with the mind I myself serve the law of God; but with the flesh the law of sin.

- Galatians 2:16 Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.
- Galatians 2:16 Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ.
- Romans 3:22 Even the righteousness of God which is by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference:

covenanted with David thy father, saying, There shall not fail thee a man to be ruler in Israel. But if ye turn away, and forsake my statutes and my commandments, which I have set before you, and shall go and serve other gods, and worship them; Then will I pluck them up by the roots out of my land which I have given them; and this house, which I have sanctified for my name, will I cast out of my sight, and will make it to be a proverb and a byword among all nations.

- Galatians 2:20 I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.
- Galatians 3:22 But the scripture hath concluded all under sin, that the promise by faith of Jesus Christ might be given to them that believe.
- Philippians 3:9 And be found in him, not having mine own righteousness, which is of the law, but that which is through the faith of Christ, the righteousness which is of God by faith:

Schoolmaster - the law still has a purpose!

- Galatians 3:19-29 Wherefore then serveth the law? It was added because of transgressions, till the seed should come to whom the promise was made; and it was ordained by angels in the hand of a mediator. Now a mediator is not a mediator of one, but God is one. Is the law then against the promises of God? God forbid: for if there had been a law given which could have given life, verily righteousness should have been by the law. But the scripture hath concluded all under sin, that the promise by faith of Jesus Christ might be given to them that believe.
- But before faith came, we were kept under the law, shut up unto the faith which should afterwards be revealed. Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith.
- But after that faith is come, we are no longer under a schoolmaster. For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus. For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ. There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus. And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.

Gentiles & the law during the Old Testament

• Romans 2:14-15 - For when the Gentiles, which have not the law, do by nature the

things contained in the law, these, having not the law, are a law unto themselves: Which shew the work of the law written in their hearts, their conscience also bearing witness, and their thoughts the mean while accusing or else excusing one another;)

The Sabbath and Israel Yestertime Exodus 31:12-17

The Sabbath is not, and never has been, for this or The subject of the Sabbath Day is a constant any other body of believers except the nation of Israel.

Exodus 31:12-17 - And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, Speak thou also unto the children of Israel, saying, Verily my sabbaths ye shall keep: for it is a sign between me and you throughout your generations; that ye may know that I am the LORD that doth sanctify you. Ye shall keep the sabbath therefore; for it is holy unto you: every one that defileth it shall surely be put to death: for whosoever doeth any work therein, that soul shall be cut off from among his people. Six days may work be done; but in the seventh is the sabbath of rest, holy to the LORD: whosoever doeth any work in the sabbath day, he shall surely be put to death. Wherefore the children of Israel shall keep the sabbath, to observe the sabbath throughout their generations, for a perpetual covenant. It is a sign between me and the children of Israel for ever: for in six days the LORD made heaven and earth, and on the seventh day he rested, and was refreshed.

The Sabbath was severely adhered to under threat of punishment.

Numbers 15:32-36 - And while the children of Israel were in the wilderness, they found a man that gathered sticks upon the sabbath day. And they that found him gathering sticks brought him unto Moses and Aaron, and unto all the congregation. And they put him in ward, because it was not declared what should

The Sabbath and the Body of Christ Today Colossians 2:13-17

issue of contention among Christians and religious organizations.

Some legalistic cults and denominations and Christians themselves even make it a vital part of their doctrinal teaching and belief.

Some go so far as to base their entire structure of doctrine on the keeping of the Sabbath.

7th Day Adventists teach that when Sunday becomes the universal 'law' for everyone to worship, then the antichrist will come. In other words, worshipping on Sunday - which they believe is the Sabbath, will be the mark of the beast.

A certain misapplication of **Revelation** 13:8 - And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.

The Apostle Paul makes very clear the fact that we who are saved under the Gospel of the grace of God have no connection whatever with the keeping of the Sabbath.

Colossians 2:16 - Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the new moon, or of the sabbath days:

He firmly reprimanded the Galatians:

• Galatians 4:9-11- But now, after that ye have known God, or rather are known of God, how turn ye again to the weak and

be done to him. And the LORD said unto Moses, The man shall be surely put to death: all the congregation shall stone him with stones without the camp. And all the congregation brought him without the camp, and stoned him with stones, and he died; as the LORD commanded Moses.

And yet, even in the gospels, Jesus Himself did activity on the Sabbath!

- Matthew 12:1 At that time Jesus went on the sabbath day through the corn; and his disciples were an hungred, and began to pluck the ears of corn, and to eat.
- Matthew 12:10-12 And, behold, there was a man which had his hand withered. And they asked him, saying, Is it lawful to heal on the sabbath days? that they might accuse him. And he said unto them, What man shall there be among you, that shall have one sheep, and if it fall into a pit on the sabbath day, will he not lay hold on it, and lift it out? How much then is a man better than a sheep? Wherefore it is lawful to do well on the sabbath days.
- Mark 6:2 And when the sabbath day was come, he began to teach in the synagogue:...
- Luke 6:6 And it came to pass also on another sabbath, that he entered into the synagogue and taught: and there was a man whose right hand was withered.
- Luke 6:7 And the scribes and Pharisees watched him, whether he would heal on the sabbath day; that they might find an accusation against him.
- John 5:16 And therefore did the Jews persecute Jesus, and sought to slay him, because he had done these things on the sabbath day.

Jesus' response to the complaints of His activity on the Sabbath:

• Matthew 12:8 - For the Son of man is

beggarly elements, whereunto ye desire again to be in bondage? Ye observe days, and months, and times, and years. I am afraid of you, lest I have bestowed upon you labour in vain.

Note: A personal Bible study will show that to a Christian, the first day of the week is far more important than the seventh.

- Acts 20:7 And upon the first day of the week, when the disciples came together to break bread, Paul preached unto them, ready to depart on the morrow; and continued his speech until midnight.
- I Corinthians 16:2 Upon the first day of the week let every one of you lay by him in store, as God hath prospered him, that there be no gatherings when I come.

- Lord even of the sabbath day.
- Luke 6:9 Then said Jesus unto them, I will ask you one thing; Is it lawful on the sabbath days to do good, or to do evil? to save life, or to destroy it?
- John 7:23 If a man on the sabbath day receive circumcision, that the law of Moses should not be broken; are ye angry at me, because I have made a man every whit whole on the sabbath day?

Forgiveness in the Kingdom Gospel Mark 11:25,26

The power of the forgiveness of sin is, and always was, in God's hands.

But He has not always dealt with the process in precisely the same manner.

In the gospels, we see...

- Mark 11:25,26 And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses. But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses.
- Luke 6:37 Judge not, and ye shall not be judged: condemn not, and ye shall not be condemned: forgive, and ye shall be forgiven:
- Matthew 6:12 And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.

The condition is clear - forgive so that God can forgive you.

That isn't the way it is today! (read on...)

Then we see that the 'forgiveness of sin' certainly wasn't complete..

• Matthew 26:28 - For this is my blood

Forgiveness in the Grace Gospel

Ephesians 4:32

Paul's mission:

• Acts 26:18 - To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.

Paul's teachings about forgiveness:

- Ephesians 4:32 And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.

- Colossians 2:13 And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses;
- Romans 4:5-8 But to him that worketh not, but believeth on him that justifieth the ungodly, his faith is counted for righteousness. Even as David also describeth the blessedness of the man, unto whom God imputeth righteousness without works, Saying, Blessed are they whose

- of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.
- Mark 1:4 John did baptize in the wilderness, and preach the baptism of repentance for the remission of sins.
- Hebrews 9:22 And almost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without shedding of blood is no remission.
- Acts 2:38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

There was then and will be in the Tribulation, etc. a need for confessing of sins in order to be forgiven...

- Acts 8:37 is another 'famous' baptism reference, but again, we see that the 'doctrine' behind it does not show Paul's teachings whatsoever just the typical teaching that the Jews had to confess that Jesus was the Christ their Messiah, etc.
- We have falsely used

 baptism 'after'
 salvation. In all truth,
 this verse can not be
 used at all for any
 example to us today!

The Future?

- Tribulation AFTER the rapture!
 - o II Thessalonians 2:13-17

- ye shall flee, like as ye fled from before the earthquake in the days of Uzziah king of Judah: and the LORD my God shall come, and all the saints with thee.
- And it shall come to pass in that day, that the light shall not be clear, nor dark:

Saved from wrath:

- Jude 14,15 And Enoch also, the seventh from Adam, prophesied of these, saying, Behold, the Lord cometh with ten thousands of his saints, To execute judgment upon all, and to convince all that are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have ungodly

- the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love; and for an helmet, the hope of salvation. For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ,
- Romans 5:9 Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him.

More support for the Rapture!

- The Holy Spirit is to be removed before the Tribulation. **II Thessalonians 2:1-8**
- In the **Book of Revelation**, the Church as we know it from Paul is not seen on earth after **Chapter three** until **Chapter nineteen**.
- The Translation of Church-age saints is said to be imminent. The Second Advent comes after specific signs.
- The Church is a mystery unrevealed in the O.T. **Ephesians 3:1-6**
- The Book of Revelation reveals that the Church as we know it through Paul is not on Earth during the Tribulation.
 - The church is not seen in chapters 4-18.
 - The witness for God in the earth is Israel.
 - The prayers of **Revelation** are those of judgment. Only Israel prayed those prayers.
 - The scorpion-like creatures of Rev 9
 are given freedom to hurt all except
 those Jews sealed by the angel of
 Revelation 7.
 - Revelation 10 identifies the events of Revelation 4-18 with those foretold by O.T. prophets.
 - The ministry of the two witnesses of Revelation 11 identifies them with Israel, etc. They minister from Jerusalem, Israel's capital.
 - The church-age believer's judgment is forever past.
 - The devil persecutes Israel, not the church.
 - o etc.

committed, and of all their hard speeches which ungodly sinners have spoken against him.

From Paul

- I Thessalonians 2:19 For what is our hope, or joy, or crown of rejoicing? Are not even ye in the presence of our Lord Jesus Christ at his coming?

Healing in the Gospels & Great Commission

Acts 5:16

The apostles doctrine included healing. We see from reading **Acts 5:11-6:15**, that the apostles were truly reaping the proper results from their carrying through of the Great Commission.

Mark 16:15-20 shows the 'results' of the apostles doctrine as they were to be taught in what many call the Great Commission.

This was all preached and 'expected' as the Scriptures state, but it was all BEFORE Paul!

Thus we see in today's Christianity teachings that are being taught in the wrong time of dispensation.

These teachings do not match with Paul. See Galatians 1:6.

Healing During Paul's Gospel Days & Today

The apostles doctrine included healing. We Keep in mind that in Paul's early ministry, he did heal!

Acts 14:8-10 Acts 19:11-20

Even in the final chapter, Paul was still healing. See Acts 28:3-9.

But as we saw makes the firm statement that now it is all passed on to the Gentiles. Acts 28:28,29a. Be it known therefore unto you, that the salvation of God is sent unto the Gentiles, and that they will hear it. And when he had said these words, the Jews departed...

Yet, in the latter times of his ministry, Paul was not able to heal anyone.

I Timothy 5:23 II Timothy 4:20

Healing is done today! God can heal anyone anytime, but he will not confuse his teachings nor will he have to use any special person to do it through.

Can the devil heal? Sure - why not. Are you not aware yet of all that he will be doing when it comes to signs, wonders, miracles, etc. That would certainly include healing, too. Read the Scriptures and know who is working in your life: the devil or the Lord!

The Way of God

Matthew 22:16

Jesus taught the way of God in truth - "...teachest the way of God truly."

- Also see:
 - o Mark 12:14
 - o Luke 20:21

Father's will of 'it' and 'him' to Jesus.

• John 6:39,40 -And this is the Father's will which hath sent me, that of all which he hath given me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day. And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day.

Jesus directly is still the way, of course.

But... see Paul now for Jesus' way more perfectly - through Paul!

• Ephesians 3:8- Unto me, who am less than the least of all saints, is this grace given, that I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ;

The Way of God More Perfectly

Acts 18:26

But today, Jesus' way is through what He revealed to Paul. It isn't a 'different' gospel, as we know 'different,' but it is more complete.

We are passed the Gospels, now we are on with time - to the dispensation of grace - through Paul, as the risen Jesus Christ taught to Paul personally.

The word 'perfect' can be defined within the King James Bible if you look to II Chronicles 8:16.

You will see that *perfect* doesn't mean without error, etc. although God's way is without error, of course.

When we let the Scriptures define words, we see that *perfect* means finished - completed.

Jesus' will of 'it' and 'him' passed on to Paul, just more perfectly now.

• Colossians 1:12,13 - Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light: Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son:

More excellent way!

• I Corinthians 12:31 - ... yet shew

I unto you a more excellent way.

Judgment based on Paul's teachings.

• Romans 2:16 - In the day when God shall judge the secrets of men by Jesus Christ according to my gospel.

Paul's ways in every church!

• I Corinthians 4:17: For this cause have I sent unto you Timotheus, who is my beloved son, and faithful in the Lord, who shall bring you into remembrance of my ways which be in Christ, as I teach every where in every church.

Way of salvation!

• Acts 16:17: The same followed Paul and us, and cried, saying, These men are the servants of the most high God, which shew unto us the way of salvation.

Any other way is wrong, no matter what it is.

• **Galatians 1:6-9**

Paul's ways show you to the God of peace!

• Philippians 4:9 - Those things, which ye have both learned, and received, and heard, and seen in me, do: and the God of peace shall be with you.

Paul's ways are still in Christ

- ...but they are the teachings of the Risen Christ to the Gentiles, not the Gospel Christ's teachings to the Jews.
- I Corinthians 4:17 For this cause have I sent unto you Timotheus, who is my beloved

son, and faithful in the Lord, who shall bring you into remembrance of my ways which be in Christ, as I teach every where in every church.

Exhort by the Lord Jesus

• I Thessalonians 4:1 Furthermore then we beseech
you, brethren, and exhort you by
the Lord Jesus, that as ye have
received of us how ye ought to
walk and to please God, so ye
would abound more and more.

In Time Past Ephesians 2:11

Ephesians 2:11 - Wherefore remember, that ye being in time past Gentiles in the flesh, who are called Uncircumcision by that which is called the Circumcision in the flesh made by hands;

The course of this world.

• Ephesians 2:2,3 - Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience: Among whom also we all had our conversation in times past in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind; and were by nature the children of wrath, even as others.

Paul had his past.

- Galatians 1:23 But they had heard only, That he which persecuted us in times past now preacheth the faith which once he destroyed.
- Galatians 1:13 For ye have heard of my conversation in time past in the Jews'

But Now Ephesians 2:13

But now...

Ephesians 2:13-18 - But now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ. For he is our peace, who hath made both one, and hath broken down the middle wall of partition between us; Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, even the law of commandments contained in ordinances; for to make in himself of twain one new man, so making peace; And that he might reconcile both unto God in one body by the cross, having slain the enmity thereby: And came and preached peace to you which were afar off, and to them that were nigh. For through him we both have access by one Spirit unto the Father.

But we...

• II Thessalonians 2:13-17 - But we are bound to give thanks alway to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of

religion, how that beyond measure I persecuted the church of God, and wasted it:

the truth: Whereunto he called you by our gospel, to the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ. Therefore, brethren, stand fast, and hold the traditions which ye have been taught, whether by word, or our epistle. Now our Lord Jesus Christ himself, and God, even our Father, which hath loved us, and hath given us everlasting consolation and good hope through grace, Comfort your hearts, and stablish you in every good word and work.

But before...

• Galatians 3:23-26 - But before faith came, we were kept under the law, shut up unto the faith which should afterwards be revealed. Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith. But after that faith is come, we are no longer under a schoolmaster. For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus.

In Ages to Come

Ephesians 2:7 - That in the ages to come he might shew the exceeding riches of his grace in his kindness toward us through Christ Jesus.

- That was written in Paul's time and so any mention of the word "beyond" is why I call our ways, "Beyond Paul" in today's 'age.
- We are able to learn of the exceeding riches of his grace today by learning Paul's teachings.'
- We are in the 'age' for these things as we now have that which is perfect, the KJB the source of these riches!

Colossians 2:2 - That their hearts might be comforted, being knit together in love, and unto all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the acknowledgement of the mystery of God, and of the Father, and of Christ;

Ephesians 1:16-18 - Cease not to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers; That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of

glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him: The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints...

Tribulation

- II Thessalonians 2:3-12
- Luke 21:22 For these be the days of vengeance, that all things which are written may be fulfilled.

Subsistence: That which supplies the means of living; as money, pay or wages... especially means barely sufficient to maintain life.

Instructing His apostles as He sent them on their missionary journeys, Jesus told them,

Matthew 6:25-34 - Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life, what ve shall eat, or what ve shall drink; nor yet for your body, what ye shall put on. Is not the life more than meat, and the body than raiment? Behold the fowls of the air: for they sow not, neither do they reap, nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feedeth them. Are ye not much better than they? Which of you by taking thought can add one cubit unto his stature? And why take ye thought for raiment? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they toil not, neither do they spin: And yet I say unto you, That even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which to day is, and to morrow is cast into the oven, shall he not much more clothe you, O ve of little faith? Therefore take no thought, saying, What Sure, we have those brethren who take care of shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed? (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things. But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

Subsistence of NT Body Saints

II Thessalonians 3:10-12

Subsistence: *That which supplies the means of* living; as money, pay or wages... especially means barely sufficient to maintain life.

There are many people today who try to just sit back and 'allow' God to take care of them in the same manner that God did in the apostles day.

Yes, if they believe the Gospels to be TO us today, and if they believe they should follow the apostles doctrine, then those verses in **Matthew** and Luke should be believed - and folks ought to quit trying to make provisions for themselves especially if they are missionaries, etc.

> So, why do they need deputation? Who takes care of the pastor today?

Of course, anyone knows that it doesn't work that way today. Once again, we see the folly of a Christianity built on the Gospels, not on Paul.

II Timothy 3:9 - But they shall proceed no further: for their folly shall be manifest unto all men, as theirs also was.

each other, and they should, if they are able.

I Timothy 6:17-19 - Charge them that are rich in this world, that they be not highminded, nor trust in uncertain riches, but in the living God, who giveth us richly all things to enjoy; That they do good, that they be rich in good works,

- Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself.
 Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof.
- Luke 9:3 And he said unto them, Take nothing for your journey, neither staves, nor scrip, neither bread, neither money; neither have two coats apiece.

The apostles were to rely wholly on miraculous provision from heaven.

Note: As Jesus ministry ended and his prophetic purpose was about to come to an end, He eventually told them:

• Luke 22:35-37 - When I sent you without purse, and scrip, and shoes, lacked ye any thing? And they said, Nothing. Then said he unto them, But now, he that hath a purse, let him take it, and likewise his scrip: and he that hath no sword, let him sell his garment, and buy one. For I say unto you, that this that is written must yet be accomplished in me, And he was reckoned among the transgressors: for the things concerning me have an end.

- ready to distribute, willing to communicate; Laying up in store for themselves a good foundation against the time to come, that they may lay hold on eternal life.
- Galatians 6:9,10 And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not. As we have therefore opportunity, let us do good unto all men, especially unto them who are of the household of faith.
- Ephesians 4:28 Let him that stole steal no more: but rather let him labour, working with his hands the thing which is good, that he may have to give to him that needeth.
- And of course, God has repeatedly shown us his grace in how He has provided through other brethren, as well the lost.

But we also have mooches and beggars and whiners waiting and actually expecting the brethren to care for them, pay their bills, buy their treats, etc.

We must remember that we are living in a different dispensation. Our instructions come from our apostle Paul:

- II Thessalonians 3:10 For even when we were with you, this we commanded you, that if any would not work, neither should he eat.
- I Timothy 5:8 : But if any provide not for his own, and specially for those of his own house, he hath denied the faith, and is worse than an infidel.

Here is a great verse from **Proverbs** on how much we need to 'have.'

Remember, because this is from the OT, we ought to know we have to get out as well, and earn our keep.

However, these two things are good for us to remember as we attempt to provide for ourselves and our families.

• Proverbs 30:7-9 - Two things have I

required of thee; deny me them not before I die: Remove far from me vanity and lies: give me neither poverty nor riches; feed me with food convenient for me: Lest I be full, and deny thee, and say, Who is the LORD? or lest I be poor, and steal, and take the name of my God in vain.

Freely Matthew 10:8

Matthew 10:7,8 - And as ye go, preach, saying, The kingdom of heaven is at hand. Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give.

Great Commission

Those signs that were to follow them during the Great Commission were given to them 'freely.'

But not following the Great Commission, instead following Paul, we see that these healings, gifts, etc. are not what is given to us 'freely' today.

Millennium/Eternity

We also see that in **Revelation 21:6; 22:17**, we see that the water of life is given freely. That would be Millennial / Eternity application.

Freely Romans 4:24

Paul, showing God's way more perfectly, shows us what was given to us 'freely'.

We certainly should see the difference between the OT Gospels and Paul's epistles when it comes to singing the song 'Freely.'

Justified freely by his grace!

• Romans 3:24 - Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:

Freely gave all things!

• Romans 8:32 - He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?

We can know what He has given us freely!

• I Corinthians 2:12 - Furthermore, when I came to Troas to preach Christ's gospel, and a door was opened unto me of the Lord,

Paul's words of preaching, thus the KJB's Epistles.

• II Corinthians 11:7 - Have I committed an offence in abasing myself that ye might be exalted, because I have preached to you the

gospel of God freely?

Word of the Lord have free course!

• II Thessalonians 3:1 - Finally, brethren, pray for us, that the word of the Lord may have free course, and be glorified, even as it is with you:

 - Can you play any instrument at all?
 - If not...
 - Therefore if I know not the meaning of the voice, I shall be unto him that speaketh a barbarian, and he that speaketh shall be a barbarian unto me. (I Corinthians 14:11)

- This all CAN be applied to music, not just about 'speaking' voices.
 - See vs 9 "likewise." and vs 15 "singing" with the spirit and with understanding.

Paul & Silas sing while in jail...

- Acts 16:23-29
- Vs 25 And at midnight Paul and Silas prayed, and sang praises unto God:
- Was it the music that 'won the guard?'
 - o the prisoners heard them, not necessarily the guard.
- or was it because they didn't leave when they could have?
 - o vs 27-30

Paul's direct words concerning music.

- Colossians 3:16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.

- Today's worship is preparing folks for fleshly worship tomorrow using false & fleshly worship today!

- Not to be used today, though, for any 'proof text' for the power and healing of music today.
 - Saul had an evil spirit,
 NOT the Spirit of
 God
- The Spirit of God is our comfort today, etc. through the King James Bible - NOT through music.

Jubal, father of...

• from the lineage of Cain

Genesis 4:21 - And his brother's name was Jubal: he was the father of all such as handle the harp and organ.

Lucifer, the Devil himself is a musician!

• Ezekiel 28:13c... the workmanship of thy tabrets and of thy pipes was prepared in thee in the day that thou wast created.

The Devil Uses All Kinds of Music Daniel 3:5,7,10,15

Daniel and Nebuchadnezzar prove that he devil knows

- how to use 'all kinds of music' not just so-called bad music such as 'rock,' etc.
- Verse 7 Therefore at that time, when all the people heard the sound of the cornet, flute, harp, sackbut, psaltery, and all kinds of musick, all the people, the nations, and the languages, fell down and worshipped the golden image that Nebuchadnezzar the king had set up.

Woe to them that are at east in Zion...

- Amos 6:1,5 Woe to them that are at ease in Zion...
 That chant to the sound of the viol, and invent to themselves instruments of musick, like David;
- Changing this verse by adding a comma and adding the word 'did,' as the modern bible versions do, this corrupted verse can than be used to show how music can be used to please ourselves, instead of God "like David did."

God refused their music.

- So, there IS a reason for God reject man's music!
- Amos 5:23 Take thou away from me the noise of thy songs; for I will not hear the melody of thy viols.

David's truthful purpose for his musical instruments.

• I Chronicles 23:5 Moreover four thousand
were porters; and four

thousand praised the LORD with the instruments which I made, said David, to praise therewith.

Play skillfully

• Psalm 33:3 - Sing unto him a new song; play skilfully with a loud noise.

Solomon wrote 2005 songs

• I Kings 4:32 - And he spake three thousand proverbs: and his songs were a thousand and five.

David - Sweet Psalmist of Israel

• II Samuel 23:1 - Now these be the last words of David. David the son of Jesse said, and the man who was raised up on high, the anointed of the God of Jacob, and the sweet psalmist of Israel, said,

Musicians were as one... with results!

• II Chronicles 5:13,14 - *It* came even to pass, as the trumpeters and singers were as one, to make one sound to be heard in praising and thanking the LORD; and when they lifted up their voice with the trumpets and cymbals and instruments of musick, and praised the LORD, saying, For he is good; for his mercy endureth for ever: that then the house was filled with a cloud, even the house of the LORD; So that the priests could not

stand to minister by reason of the cloud: for the glory of the LORD had filled the house of God.

Jesus sang an hymn just before He was arrested!

• Matthew 26:30 - And when they had sung an hymn, they went out into the mount of Olives.

Over 500 verses in the King James Bible on music!

We can even learn from Moses:

- Moses can teach us a lot about music in churches today who are trying to have favour with all the people with their music! (Acts 2:47)
- Numbers 20:11 -And Moses lifted up his hand, and with his rod he smote the rock twice: and the water came out abundantly, and the congregation drank, and their beasts also.
- Even though Moses received abundant water, he still was wrong.
- So, just because 'music' today can bring in a 'crowd,' that doesn't mean it is right!

Accountability During Gospels Matthew 12:36

Romans 2:1-11

Those who strive to:

- follow the law
- escape the judgment of God
- despise the goodness, forbearance and longsuffering of God.

Christian's Accountability Today I Corinthians 3:11-15

We see today, though, that in order to be judged by Jesus Christ according to Paul's gospel, we must follow Paul's gospel the details of our judgment today - for Christians.

• Romans 2:16 - In the day when God shall judge the secrets of men by Jesus Christ according to my gospel.

follow their own works!

God will render to every man according to his deeds.

Revelation 20:11

Accountable for every word.

- Matthew 12:35-37 A good man out of the good treasure of the heart bringeth forth good things: and an evil man out of the evil treasure bringeth forth evil things. But I say unto you, That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment. For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned.
- Matthew 15:18-20 But those things which proceed out of the mouth come forth from the heart; and they defile the man. For out of the heart proceed evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, blasphemies: These are the things which defile a man: but to eat with unwashen hands defileth not a man.
- Romans 14:10-13 -But why dost thou judge thy brother? or why dost thou set at nought thy brother? for we shall all stand before the judgment seat of Christ. For it is written, As I live, saith the Lord, every knee shall bow to me, and every tongue shall confess to God. So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God. Let us not therefore judge one another any more: but judge this rather, that no man put a stumblingblock or an occasion to fall in his brother's way. I know, and am persuaded by the Lord Jesus, that there is nothing unclean of itself: but to him that esteemeth any thing to be unclean, to him it is unclean.
- I Corinthians 3:10-15
- II Corinthians 5:10 For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad.
- Colossians 3:23-25 And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men; Knowing that of the Lord ye shall receive the reward of the inheritance: for ye serve the Lord Christ. But he that doeth wrong shall receive for the wrong which he hath done: and there is no respect of persons.
- I Timothy 5:24,25 Some men's sins are open beforehand, going before to judgment; and some men they follow after. Likewise also the good works of some are manifest beforehand; and they that are otherwise cannot be hid.
- Romans 4:6 Even as David also describeth the blessedness of the man, unto whom God imputeth righteousness without works,
- Romans 11:6 And if by grace, then is it no more of works: otherwise grace is no more grace. But if it be of works, then is it no more grace: otherwise work is no more work.
- Galatians 2:16 Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.
- Ephesians 2:8,9 For by grace are ye saved

through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast. For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

We will be accountable for our works!

"Pride" in Keeping the Law Today Luke 11:28

Pride today from thinking they are keeping the law!

- They apparently think they can actually 'sin no more.'
 - After all, Jesus taught... "go, and sin no more." John 8:11
- I have seen a outward 'pride' in my many conversations with those who believe they are following IN Christ's footsteps, or those who believe they are 'being like Christ' as many preachers say they should be or even just those folks like 7th Day Adventists who really believe that even after they are saved, they are keeping the law.
- Or... they have a great time of confession claiming I John 1:9, etc.

God's Blessings Based on Their Walk?

• They are proud of themselves as they say that God is 'blessing' their lives with answer to prayer / there is 'power' in their prayers for others, etc.

False godliness!

- Yes, they have a godliness about them, but it certainly isn't according to Scriptures.
- II Timothy 3:5 Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away.

Gospel Law keepers!

• They WERE told to keep the law, etc. in the gospels, but we are not told to keep the law today as we live in Paul's dispensation of grace!

"Confidence" & a Joy in Being Dead to the Law

Ephesians 3:12

We are delivered from the law!

- Romans 7:6 But now we are delivered from the law, that being dead wherein we were held; that we should serve in newness of spirit, and not in the oldness of the letter.
- Galatians 2:19 For I through the law am dead to the law, that I might live unto God.
- Galatians 2:20-21 I do not frustrate the grace of God: for if righteousness come by the law, then Christ is dead in vain. I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.
- Romans 10:4 For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to every one that believeth.
- Romans 4:15 Because the law worketh wrath: for where no law is, there is no transgression.
- Colossians 2:14-15 Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross; And having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it.
- Galatians 2:19 For I through the law am dead to the law, that I might live unto God.

- The 'Ten' or all the others, too?
 - o Matthew 19:17 And he said unto him, Why callest thou me good? there is none good but one, that is, God: but if thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments.
- An honest and good heart?
 - Luke 8:15 But that on the good ground are they, which in an honest and good heart, having heard the word, keep it, and bring forth fruit with patience.
- Hear what part of the word of God?
 - Luke 11:28 But he said, Yea rather, blessed are they that hear the word of God, and keep it.
- Never see death?
 - o John 8:51 Verily, verily, I say unto you, If a man keep my saying, he shall never see death.
- If we love him? A pastoral guilt trip?
 - o John 14:15 If ye love me, keep my commandments.
- How does He manifest himself today?

- Do they even hear any word?

- Imitate / be like Christ?
 - o John 15:10 If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love.

Jesus Knew!

 And yet, Jesus even knew that nobody was truly keeping the law then, and there is certainly no one keeping the law today! • Galatians 3:13 - Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree:

Paul had Confidence!

- Acts 28:31 Preaching the kingdom of God, and teaching those things which concern the Lord Jesus Christ, with all confidence, no man forbidding him.
- II Corinthians 10:2 But I beseech you, that I may not be bold when I am present with that confidence, wherewith I think to be bold against some, which think of us as if we walked according to the flesh.

We also should have that confidence!

- Ephesians 3:12 In whom we have boldness and access with confidence by the faith of him.
- Philippians 3:3 For we are the circumcision, which worship God in the spirit, and rejoice in Christ Jesus, and have no confidence in the flesh.

Paul had a joy!

- Romans 5:11 And not only so, but we also joy in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom we have now received the atonement.
- Romans 14:17 For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.
- Romans 15:13 Now the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that ye may abound in hope, through the power of the Holy Ghost.
- II Corinthians 1:24 Not for that we have dominion over your faith, but are helpers of your joy: for by faith ye stand.
- II Corinthians 2:3 And I wrote this same unto you, lest, when I came, I

• John 7:19 - Did not Moses give you the law, and yet none of you keepeth the law? Why go ye about to kill me?

Paul knew and we know today!

- Paul knew they didn't keep the law back then!
 - o Galatians 6:13 For neither they themselves who are circumcised keep the law; but desire to have you circumcised, that they may glory in your flesh.

Keepers of the Law Today? Why?

- Why would anyone today think they are actually keeping the law even more so, why would they not want to try knowing what the Risen Christ teaches?
 - o Romans 3:10-13 As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one: There is none that understandeth, there is none that seeketh after God. They are all gone out of the way, they are together become unprofitable; there is none that doeth good, no, not one.
 - o Romans 3:20 Therefore by the deeds of the law there shall no flesh be justified in his sight: for by the law is the knowledge of sin.
 - o Romans 3:28 Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the law.
 - o Galatians 2:16 Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.
 - o Galatians 3:11 But that no man is justified by the law in the sight of God, it is evident: for, The just shall live by faith.
 - o Galatians 3:24 Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith.

- should have sorrow from them of whom I ought to rejoice; having confidence in you all, that my joy is the joy of you all.
- II Corinthians 7:4 Great is my boldness of speech toward you, great is my glorying of you: I am filled with comfort, I am exceeding joyful in all our tribulation.
- Galatians 5:22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith,
- Philippians 1:25 And having this confidence, I know that I shall abide and continue with you all for your furtherance and joy of faith;
- Colossians 1:11 Strengthened with all might, according to his glorious power, unto all patience and longsuffering with joyfulness;
- I Thessalonians 1:6 And ye became followers of us, and of the Lord, having received the word in much affliction, with joy of the Holy Ghost:

Paul was thankful!

- Romans 1:8 First, I thank my God through Jesus Christ for you all, that your faith is spoken of throughout the whole world.
- Romans 1:21 Because that, when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.
- Romans 6:17 But God be thanked, that ye were the servants of sin, but ye have obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine which was delivered you.
- Romans 7:25 I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord. So then with the mind I myself serve the law of God; but with the flesh the law of sin.
- Romans 14:6 He that regardeth the day, regardeth it unto the Lord; and he that regardeth not the day, to the Lord he doth not regard it. He that eateth, eateth to the Lord, for he giveth God thanks; and he that eateth not, to the

- Lord he eateth not, and giveth God thanks.
- I Corinthians 15:57 But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.
- II Corinthians 2:14 Now thanks be unto God, which always causeth us to triumph in Christ, and maketh manifest the savour of his knowledge by us in every place.
- II Corinthians 4:15 For all things are for your sakes, that the abundant grace might through the thanksgiving of many redound to the glory of God.
- Colossians 1:12 Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light:
- Colossians 2:7 Rooted and built up in him, and stablished in the faith, as ye have been taught, abounding therein with thanksgiving.
- Colossians 3:15 And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful.

- Romans 12:1,2 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- I Corinthians 9:27 But I keep under my body, and bring it into subjection: lest that by any means, when I have preached to others, I myself should be a castaway.
- I Corinthians 11:2 Now I praise you, brethren, that ye remember me in all

- things, and keep the ordinances, as I delivered them to you.
- I Corinthians 15:2 By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain.
- Ephesians 4:3 Endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.
- I Timothy 5:22 Lay hands suddenly on no man, neither be partaker of other men's sins: keep thyself pure.
- I Timothy 6:14 That thou keep this commandment without spot, unrebukeable, until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ:
- I Timothy 6:20 O Timothy, keep that which is committed to thy trust, avoiding profane and vain babblings, and oppositions of science falsely so called:

The Lord is faithful, Shouldn't We Be Too?

- Philippians 4:7 And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.
- II Thessalonians 3:3 But the Lord is faithful, who shall stablish you, and keep you from evil.
- II Timothy 1:12 For the which cause I also suffer these things: nevertheless I am not ashamed: for I know whom I have believed, and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day.

Tribulation Times of confidence!

If?

• Hebrews 3:14 - For we are made partakers of Christ, if we hold the beginning of our confidence stedfast unto the end;

Reward? Cast not away?

Hebrews 10:35 - Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompence of reward.

Confidence because of the walk being clean enough!

- I John 2:28 And now, little children, abide in him; that, when he shall appear, we may have confidence, and not be ashamed before him at his coming.
- Revelation 14:12 Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus.

Personal answer to prayer dependent on their clean walk!

• I John 5:14 - And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us:

Tribulation Teachings If Taught Today

- The above Tribulation verses would be considered false gospel!
- Galatians 1:8,9 But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed. As we said before, so say I now again, If any man preach any other gospel unto you than that ye have received, let him be accursed.

Heavenly Father Matthew 6:14

in the past by Mormons is quickly becoming a common and popular phrase by more and more Christians in their reference to God.

Spiritual Father

Romans 4:11

The title of *Heavenly father*, which has been used Our father? Indirectly, yes, but not our heavenly father - but instead He is our *Spiritual Father* through Abraham and our faith.

The heavenly father certainly is not as described by the Mormons as 'once a man' and having spirit Romans 4:11 - And he received the sign of children in heaven to send down to earth, etc.

is a term used only by the Jews, and of course...

...the Jews are his people.

- **Deuteronomy 7:6 -** *For thou art an holy* people unto the LORD thy God: the LORD thy God hath chosen thee to be a special people unto himself, above all people that are upon the face of the earth.
- I Peter 2:9 But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light:
- Romans 11:28 As concerning the gospel, they are enemies for your sakes: but as touching the election, they are beloved for the fathers' sakes.

Thus, He would be called their Heavenly

Matthew 6:14 - For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you:

Matthew 6:26 - Behold the fowls of the air: for they sow not, neither do they reap, nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feedeth them. Are ye not much better than they?

Matthew 6:32 - (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things.

Matthew 15:13 - But he answered and said, Every plant, which my heavenly Father hath not planted, shall be rooted up.

Matthew 18:35 - *So likewise shall my heavenly* Father do also unto you, if ye from your hearts forgive not every one his brother their trespasses.

The father of them that believe!

circumcision, a seal of the righteousness of the faith which he had yet being uncircumcised: that he might However, we see by rightly divided Scriptures, it be the father of all them that believe, though they be not circumcised; that righteousness might be imputed unto them also:

The father of the uncircumcision!

Romans 4:12 - And the father of circumcision to them who are not of the circumcision only, but who also walk in the steps of that faith of our father Abraham, which he had being yet uncircumcised.

Abraham - the father of us all!

Romans 4:16 - Therefore it is of faith, that it might be by grace; to the end the promise might be sure to all the seed; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the faith of Abraham; who is the father of us all,

Abraham, a father of many nations!

Romans 4:17-18 - (As it is written, I have made thee a father of many nations,) before him whom he believed, even God, who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were. Who against hope believed in hope, that he might become the father of many nations, according to that which was spoken, So shall thy seed be.

Father / The Father, etc.

There are too many references to list, but Paul calls him as should we, 'the Father,' or 'Father' - or even with a small 'f' - 'father.'

But to call him our "Heavenly Father" is to once again, use an incorrect term - a term that is not true concerning Christians today.

Because of our faith and trust in Christ, the Father becomes our spiritual father, not our heavenly Father. That term still belongs to the Jews.

Luke 11:13 - If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask him?
