Acts 13:47; 18:24-25; Romans 2:16

Furthermore then we beseech you, brethren, and exhort you by the Lord Jesus, that as ye have received of us how ye ought to walk and to please God, so ye would abound more and more. I Thessalonians 4:1

For this cause have I sent unto you Timotheus, who is my beloved son, and faithful in the Lord, who shall bring you into remembrance of my ways which be in Christ, as I teach every where in every church.

Be ye followers of me, even as I also am of Christ.

If ye continue in the faith grounded and settled, and be not moved away from the hopes of the gospel, which ye have heard, and which was preached to every creature which is under heaven; whereof I Paul am made a minister.

Colossians 1:23

Even the mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but now is made manifest to his saints:

Colossians 1:26

Paul, the ONLY Apostle to the Gentiles,

meaning Paul writes directly 'to' you & me!


He is to be our 'only' minister/apostle!

We can certainly learn about Jesus from the Gospels when He was on the earth with His day to day life, His miracles and of course, His crucifixion, death, burial and resurrection, etc.

But just understand and remember: Jesus was directing His ministry to the Jews then;

NOT to the Gentiles! ...yet!

So having that understanding means we are NOT to follow the "apostle's doctrine" from the original twelve apostles as found in the gospels and Acts 2:41-47 because we are now told to follow Paul's doctrine to the Gentiles ONLY!



But the Lord said unto him, Go thy way: for he is a chosen vessel unto me, to bear my name before the Gentiles, and kings, and the children of Israel:

Acts 9:15

And the apostles and brethren that were in Judaea heard that the Gentiles had also received the word of God.

Acts 11:1

When they heard these things, they held their peace, and glorified God, saying,

Then hath God also to the Gentiles granted repentance unto life.

Acts 11;18

And when the Jews were gone out of the synagogue, the Gentiles besought that these words might be preached to them the next sabbath. Acts 13:42

Then Paul and Barnabas waxed bold, and said, it was necessary that the word of God should first have been spoken to you: but seeing ye put it from you, and judge yourselves unworthy of everlasting life, lo, we turn to the Gentiles.

For so hath the Lord commanded us, saying,

I have set thee to be a light of the Gentiles,
that thou shouldest be for salvation unto the ends of the earth.

Acts 13:46,47

And when they were come, and had gathered the church together, they rehearsed all that God had done with them, and how he had opened the door of faith unto the Gentiles.

Acts 14:27

And being brought on their way by the church, they passed through Phenice and Samaria, declaring the conversion of the Gentiles: and they caused great joy unto all the brethren.

Acts 15:3

And when they opposed themselves, and blasphemed, he shook his raiment, and said unto them, Your blood be upon your own heads; I am clean: from henceforth I will go unto the Gentiles.

Acts 18:6

And when he had saluted them, he declared particularly what things God had wrought among the Gentiles by his ministry. Acts 21:19

But rise, and stand upon thy feet: for I have appeared unto thee for this purpose, to make thee a minister and a witness both of these things which thou hast seen, and of those things in the which I will appear unto thee;

Delivering thee from the people, and from the Gentiles, unto whom now I send thee,
To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God,
that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them
which are sanctified by faith that is in me.

Acts 26:16-18

But shewed first unto them of Damascus, and at Jerusalem, and throughout all the coasts of Judaea, and then to the Gentiles, that they should repent and turn to God, and do works meet for repentance.

Acts 26:20

Having therefore obtained help of God, I continue unto this day, witnessing both to small and great, saying none other things than those which the prophets and Moses did say should come:

That Christ should suffer, and that he should be the first that should rise from the dead, and should shew light unto the people, and to the Gentiles.

Acts 26:22-23

Be it known therefore unto you, that the salvation of God is sent unto the Gentiles, and that they will hear it. Acts 28:28

> For though I be free from all men, yet have I made myself servant unto all, that I might gain the more. I Corinthians 9:19

To the weak became I as weak, that I might gain the weak:

I am made all things to all men, that I might by all means save some.

I Corinthians 9:22

Knowing therefore the terror of the Lord, we persuade men; but we are made manifest unto God; and I trust also are made manifest in your consciences. II Corinthians 5:11

For though I made you sorry with a letter, I do not repent, though I did repent:
for I perceive that the same epistle hath made you sorry, though it were but for a season.
For if I have boasted any thing to him of you, I am not ashamed;
but as we spake all things to you in truth, even so our boasting,
which I made before Titus, is found a truth.
II Corinthians 7:14

But though I be rude in speech, yet not in knowledge; but we have been throughly made manifest among you in all things. II Corinthians 11:6

And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness.

> Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest up on me. II Corinthians 12:9

In the day when God shall judge the secrets of men by Jesus Christ according to my gospel.

Now to him that is of power to stablish you according to my gospel, and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery, which was kept secret since the world began,

I marvel that ye are so soon removed from him that called you into the grace of Christ unto another gospel: Which is not another; but there be some that trouble you, and would pervert the gospel of Christ.

But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed.

Galatians 1:6-8

As we said before, so say I now again, If any man preach any other gospel unto you than that ye have received, let him be accursed.

For do I now persuade men, or God? or do I seek to please men? for if I yet pleased men, I should not be the servant of Christ.

But I certify you, brethren, that the gospel which was preached of me is not after man.

For I neither received it of man, neither was I taught it, but by the revelation of Jesus Christ. Galatians 1:9-12

But when it pleased God, who separated me from my mother's womb, and called me by his grace,

To reveal his Son in me, that I might preach him among the heathen;

immediately I conferred not with flesh and blood:

Galatians 1:16,17

Be not thou therefore ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me his prisoner:
but be thou partaker of the afflictions of the gospel
according to the power of God;

II Timothy 1:8
