WHAT DOES 'NOT' BRING True Peace, Joy and Understanding...

Preface

The reading, preaching and teaching that does NOT bring an assurance of a deep peace, joy and understanding is that preaching and teaching preachers and pastors are drooling out of their mouths these days along with all their books, magazines, 'scripture' quotes, studies, comments, so-called 'Christian music' – even amongst those rare conversations among 'christians.'

It is that simple, folks. The lack of true peace, joy and understanding is the result of preaching and teaching only from the Gospels, Acts 1-8, Hebrews, James, I II Peter, I II III John, Jude.

Now, I will ask another question that I figure you are already asking as you read this: Why even care what 'they' preach and teach; why not just concentrate on what DOES bring us that deep peace, joy and understanding? While that is true, I will still answer that question in this study!

As we know, deceived and deceiving pastors, etc. are actually preparing their congregations for the tribulation. But of course that is fine for them because many of them believe and teach that the 'church' will be going through the tribulation; which honestly, we can see that the modern 'church' WILL be going through the tribulation because their false gospel produces false Christians who are unknowingly following and worshipping Satan (as that has been his plan all along – to be like the most High) and because of their false bibles and worldly music worship.

So as it stands, today's local church is right on target – for the tribulation! They are being prepared to go through the coming great tribulation who will then be knowingly worshipping the coming of the anti-Christ, as pointed out in **Revelation 6** and **I Peter 5:8**.

So again, while those preachers and people are doing a fair job within their religious lives, they are, in fact, preaching from the wrong dispensation. They continue to live under their own design of the severity of God (before Jesus was glorified) while the risen Christ teaches - to 'us Gentiles in the know today' - the dispensation of grace of God – which brings to us the goodness of God and I'll say it again, NOT THE SEVERITY OF GOD!

According to Romans 2:4... the goodness of God leadeth thee to repentance, NOT the severity of God, which when preached today, only drives people away from the truth of the living God, while at the same time, preparing the deceived self-defined Christian for the coming of the antichrist!

The more you and I learn about the goodness of God, the more we understand it is our reasonable service to try to do the things that please God. Just like our children... the more they

realize the true love we have for them, the more they try to please us as parents. That is called maturing, although I will say it does take longer for some more than others...

Then we have the 'christians' that only and always hear about the severity of God who actually don't seem to want the true living God as they have no clue about the goodness of God – only the fear and severity. They end up living hypocritical lives of lies hoping God's love along with their occasional confession will cover ALL their daily sins – as they go on feeding their flesh. Also, like children, the more parents make them 'obey or else', the more they lie and hide stuff so they do not have to face parental wrath. (and when they do and get their spanking, they still do it all again.)

The law creates liars and hypocrites – true love and grace creates real maturity.

Ok – I know most of you already know that... so let us go on to part III... For part III, let us consider:

What Specifically Does NOT Bring True Peace, Joy and Understanding!!

Answer: Trying to follow the apostolic doctrine through Hebrews, James, I II Peter, I II III John, Jude, the Gospels and Acts 1-8. It only brings conceit, arrogance, and a false hope.

First of all, as an update, I will tell you that I have spent the last few boring months 'at the zeum' reading again **Hebrews**, **James**, **I II Peter**, **I II III John**, **Jude**, **Mathew 24,25** and **Acts 1-8**. It was many years ago when I first 'got into Paul Only' that I knew, as a local church congregation, we had to go through those same books to find out the contrasts between those books and Paul's books. As a result, we all became very solid in looking to Paul, not to the apostles, nor to what I began to call the Tribulation books: **Hebrews**, **James**, **I II Peter**, **I II III John**, **Jude**. (Notice the dispensational placement of those books at the END in the King James Bible!)

So, as I did it all again for my own personal review, I can tell you folks again – the very reasons we should actually be able to get true peace, joy and understanding from reading in those books, along with all the other OT books, etc. is because we know we do NOT have to try to get our peace, joy and understanding from reading in those books, along with all those other OT books.

So, as we read the following 'non-Paul' books: Hebrews, James, I II Peter, I II III John, Jude, Gospels and Acts 1-8, etc...

- 1) We grow in appreciation for the dispensation of the grace of God!
- 2) We grow deeper in appreciation and understanding between the difference between th severity of God and the goodness of God!
- 3) We grow in understanding of the king of heaven, the kingdom of God and even Satan's kingdom.

- 4) We grow in appreciation for Paul's doctrine along with his manner of life for us as our ensample, NOT our example knowing we are not told to 'imitate' Paul, just follow him as he follows the risen Christ!
- 5) We grow in joy and gladness that we do NOT have to live under this preaching guilt today!
- 6) We see just how that stuff was pounded into our minds so deeply over the years and how hard it is and yet how necessary it is for us to delete those teachings from our guilt-ridden minds and memory. No thanks to the preaching from those evil seducing men who are deceived and were deceiving us over the many years.
- 7) We have seen over our years with Paul and Paulson, how learning the way of God more perfectly takes years. While we grasp the simplicity of Christ right away, we also have learned a deeper understanding as we continue to read, live, read more, live more years and continue to read even more.
- 8) We see some great Jewish history, not only in the OT, but in the history reviews from Paul and Stephen in Acts 6:8-15; 7:1-60; Romans 9, 11. We see Jewishness as a nation being born, the need to be 'born-again,' their rejection of the very Christ they were wanting then how they so hated Paul to the Jews today; we also can see the future of the nation of Israel.
- 9) We see the same mission from Paul towards Gentiles that Jeremiah had towards Jews ... to tell people they are rejecting the very words of the Lord. The Gentiles today, by their rejecting the very words of God, they are rejecting the goodness of God. The Jews seemed to not fear the severity of God during the time of Jeremiah thus he was rather 'outspoken.' However, with Paul, there is no need to shout in the temples or on street corners as did Jeremiah. Paul simply says, And the servant of the Lord must not strive; but be gentle unto all men, apt to teach, patient, In meekness instructing those that oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the truth; And that they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will.
- When you start reading **Hebrews** through **Jude**, you must have a solid mindset that you are beginning to read about the great tribulation that is about to come upon the world. Don't let yourself think anything you read might 'still' have some bearing on your walk today. 100% of our walk today is found in Paul's books. If there is anything in the 'tribulation books' that sounds like Paul, that is fine, but just so you know Paul's writings enough to recognize those few similarities. Remember, the consequences of their walk in the great tribulation deals with the severity of God! That is not our concern today.
- I guarantee that you will hear ALL of what preachers are preaching today. I was reminded repeatedly of so many sermons that all were derived from these books. Many of those sermons I even preached in my early years as a novice Baptist pastor / preacher. I am ashamed of those sermons. My frustration is I am sure some of them are still online and in the web forever. I have tried to delete them as I find them but my whole ministry was a learning the way of God more perfectly over those years. As many of you have said to me, the year 2009 was probably the best year of the preaching and teaching... but I know I have certainly 'learned the way of God even that more perfectly' since 2009 right up to today 2020.
- 12) You can read exactly what Paul said to the Jews in Acts 9:20 for there is no other reason to have Hebrews in the KJB other than to record for us what he was telling the Jews

- in the synagogues when he first got 'saved.' It is more than obvious that Hebrews is NOT to us Gentiles today. Paul was continuing the message from the apostles, especially from the book of John, that Christ was the son of God that is NOT the way of salvation today.
- BEFORE Paul arrived onto the scene. If the Jews had listened to Peter and not killed Stephen, then all what James, Peter, John, and Jude wrote, that would have all taken place without Paul coming onto the scene in Acts 9. It would have gone from Acts 7 to James, I II Peter, I II III John and Jude. There would be NO Romans to Philemon in our KJB. In fact, there would be no need for a KJB see I John 2:27. Without a KJB, there would have to be the true anointing that so many people mistakenly think takes place today... But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him.

There is no joy, peace and understanding if we get into the 'sailboat' with Peter, James, and John in that famous children's Sunday School song! We want to be in the ship with Paul, even when it shipwrecks, because we should know how to swim safely to shore!

So, while there is NO joy, peace and understanding in the preaching and teaching of **Hebrews** through **Jude**, **Acts 1-8** and the **Gospels**, WE can still find joy, peace and understanding in those books because we know those books are **NOT WRITTEN TO US TODAY!**

Those books are 'advanced written revelation' of what is going to be taking place 'soon' in the times of the great tribulation – the last days – time of Jacob's trouble, etc. and in **great detail**!

Final Comments 7/21/2020

After finishing this 'study,' I stayed up much of the night 'googling' the churches I had been involved in over the years... Las Vegas – Pastor Michael Matijevich; New York – Pastor George Grace; New York – Pastor Hal Roscoe; South Dakota – Pastor Tim Godin; Idaho – Pastor Curt Kral. I guess I was curious as to their 'status' in 2020.

EVERYONE of them is still a KJB 'only' Baptist church but they sure don't say much about the KJB as being 'only' – definitely not right divided! They all also claim they follow the Great Commission; emphasize the cross; have a strong emphasis on 'worship' with the new music; and their sermon 'material' comes from the same books I mentioned.

How can they miss the simplicity of following Paul 'only.' I would not 'understand' (having doubts, etc. why me? Am I wrong? Why don't they get it?) if it was not for I Corinthians 1:27-30. Still, it boggles my mind and saddens me that those guys are so deceived and are deceiving their congregations – they should know better. I guess that happens when you push church attendance and success more than a KJB bible rightly divided with Paul! I am glad I am no longer with them!

Bonus to Part III **Details of the Deceived and Deceiving!**

I am sure that you folks in our webfamily from over the years do NOT need me to point things out in those books. As you read, I would hope that you would recognize a lot of what you have heard before you wised up with Paul and learned how to rightly divide the word of truth!

I do believe that we are to 'follow' Paul's books but read all from Genesis to Revelation. Just remember that Paul's books are TO us and the rest of the Bible is there FOR us.

But I am still going to try to include some of the chapters in those books and highlight some of the things I either heard preached or even preached myself. I am basically doing this for myself, as that has been the purpose for my website – to pass on what I learn. And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also.

If any modern Christian were to look into these notes, hopefully they would recognize the same stuff they are hearing today from their pastor. Maybe this would help them realize they are being deceived by evil seducing men preaching from 1) the 'wrong' Bible and 2) from the wrong dispensation as they themselves are deceived by their bible education and seminary time, etc. They are Bible correctors; they reject the inspired and preserved words of the Lord. Read I Timothy 6 to read what God thinks of them, no matter how nice and loving they are!
