The 'Love of God Lie' Today!

Another one of the lies being put forth by today's pastors, preachers, books, videos, youtubers, farce-bookers, twinkle-tweeters, etc. is that God loves everyone! They then proceed with all this baloney about God loving everyone means we also should have unconditional love towards everyone no matter what their book cover is in life. You know the crowd, the 'alphabet perversions', (LGBTQRSTUVWAYZ people) along with those that reject, change, hate the KJB and the teachings from Paul; those that 'scribe to new age religions, those that attend all the major and minor denominations, those that simply reject God, hate God or are mad at God – even if they don't believe He exists, those that abuse and kill children, parents of the same... etc.

Their point is that God still loves them, so should we.

My point is that God does NOT love them, nor should we!

There are two things they must do in order to make this false application.

- 1. They must change the inspired and preserved Scriptures:
 - a. **John 3:16** For God so loved the world... has been changed to For God so loves the world... They make it sound like God does love everyone present tense, even those who have not received His Son.

This is NOT TRUE: God is God – a Holy God – and he LOVED the world that He gave His only begotten Son – if they reject that Son, then they are rejecting the love of God.

b. **Ephesians 2:4** is changed from *loved us* to *loves us*.

Again, they do not teach that God once offered His love to the world when He sent His only begotten Son. Without God's only begotten Son, they can not and do not have the love of God.

If you do have the risen Christ as your Saviour, you **DO** have the love of God... but if you do not have the risen Christ as your Saviour, then you do **NOT** have the love of God.

- **2.** They must go to those 'other' books in the Bible:
 - a. They have to 'ignore' Paul's writings in order to prove their point.
 - b. They go to John 16:27, I John 4:10,11.

Simply put, those verses are NOT written to us. They were written to the Jews in the gospel days – which soon will be brought back to application during the coming tribulation so as it was during the gospel days, God's love will be based on the obedience of their walk – and can and will come and go. But today's doctrine of the risen Christ is not yesterday's doctrine nor will it tomorrow's.

Of course, Paul talks about the Love of God. But he is directing his words towards us – the brethren and NOT TO THE LOST.

We should never tell a 'lost person' that God 'loves' them! If they get the false notion that God already loves them, then they would figure that God would not reject them after their death; they

would still figure they should receive those supposed great blessings those same pastors talk about? And if that doesn't happen, then they would figure God is 'not real.' One lie begets another lie begets another lie, etc.

Question: What DOES Paul say about God's love, you ask?

Answer:

Romans 5:5 - And hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us.

Romans 8:39 - Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

I Corinthians 2:9 - But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him.

II Corinthians 13:11 - Finally, brethren, farewell. Be perfect, be of good comfort, be of one mind, live in peace; and the God of love and peace shall be with you.

II Corinthians 13:14 - The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Ghost, be with you all. Amen.

Ephesians 3:19 - And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God.

II Thessalonians 3:5 - And the Lord direct your hearts into the love of God, and into the patient waiting for Christ.

And then there is this 'key' verse to make my point as clear as can be!

Titus 3:4-7 - But after that the kindness and love of God our Saviour toward man appeared, Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost; Which he shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Saviour; That being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life.

God's love is always there with those of us who have received it! It just isn't there for those who reject it!

Although, if the rejecters change their mind and seek the love of God, it will still be there for them!

Instead of preaching about the love of God in such a false manner, pastors ought to be talking about the goodness of God today! They seem to have substituted the false teaching of the 'love of God' in place of the truth today - the 'goodness of God.'

Romans 11:22 - Behold therefore the goodness and severity of God: on them which fell, severity; but toward thee, goodness, if thou continue in his goodness: otherwise thou also shalt be cut off.
