so that you may not be sluggish, but imitators of those who through faith and patience inherit the promises.

Who is going to harm you if you are eager to do good? Now who will harm you if you become imitators of that which is good? But even if you should suffer for what is right, you are blessed.

II Thess 3:7 - *For yourselves know how ye ought to follow us: for we behaved not ourselves disorderly among you;*

II Thess 3:9 - *Not because we have not power, but to make ourselves an ensample unto you to follow us.*

I Thess 5:15 - *See that none render evil for evil unto any man; but ever follow that which is good, both among yourselves, and to all men.*

We switch from imitate to pursue

For you yourselves know how you ought to imitate us; we were not idle when we were with you

We did this to give you an example to imitate, not because we didn't have a right to insist on financial support.

Make sure that no one ever pays back one wrong with another wrong. Instead, always try to do what is good for each other and everyone else.

See that no one repays evil for evil to anyone, but always pursue what is good for one another and for all.

Hebrews 13:7 - *Remember them which have the rule over you, who have spoken unto you the word of God: whose faith follow, considering the end of their conversation.*

III John 1:11 - *Beloved, follow not that which is evil, but that which is good. He that doeth good is of God: but he that doeth evil hath not seen God.*

The faith from Tribulation leaders but pastors claim this today for their people's own faith!

During time of great tribulation when their salvation is based on their walk.

Remember your leaders, who spoke God's message to you; reflect on the outcome of their lives and imitate their faith.

Beloved, do not imitate evil, but imitate good. He who does good is of God; he who does evil has not seen (discerned or experienced) God [has enjoyed no vision of Him and does not know Him at all].

Follow

Follow is the correct word because we are dead unto the law and dead unto sin, so we don't 'have' to imitate or copy it! Just mature and follow the best we can... We have the judgment seat of Christ to deal with our works, etc.

I Timothy 6:11 - *But thou, O man of God, flee these things; and follow after righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, meekness.*

II Timothy 2:22 - *Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart.*

Romans 9:30 - *What shall we say then? That the Gentiles, which followed not after righteousness, have attained to righteousness, even the righteousness which is of faith.*

Hebrews 12:14, *Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord:*

'Eschew' - to flee from; to shun; to avoid

I Peter 3:11, *Let him eschew evil, and do good; let him seek peace, and ensue it.*

'Ensue' - to follow in a train of events or course of time; to succeed; to come after.

Pursue

Pursue: to follow as an example; to imitate. To endeavor to attain to; to strive to reach or gain. To them, if they don't attain / don't live that obedient life, then they don't have God's blessing! So, it is still the 'law of liberty'!

But you, man of God, flee from all this, and pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, endurance and gentleness.

Flee the evil desires of youth and pursue righteousness, faith, love and peace, along with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart.

What then shall we say? That the Gentiles, who did not pursue righteousness, have obtained it, a righteousness that is by faith;

Pursue peace with everyone, and holiness – without it no one will see the Lord.

Try to live in peace with all people. And try to live lives free from sin. If anyone's life is not holy, he will never see the Lord.

They must turn from evil and do good; they must seek peace and pursue it.

So, because of that magnificent “*goodness of God*,” taught only by Paul and found only in a King James 1611 Bible, I sincerely hope this Bible study video presentation has brought you to a new level of Biblical understanding or to at least have created in you a desire for a new spiritual awareness.

Or, maybe you just need to receive that ‘new beginning’ with a soul saving ‘*quicken*ing’ in your life based on what you have just learned from the Risen Christ, through Paul, and of course, as found only in the King James 1611 Bible. (And I don’t mean that modern ‘born-again’ Jewish teaching stuff, either)

Quickened - THIS IS SIMPLE SALVATION! - Saved

That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.

For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. Romans 10:9,10

In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise, Ephesians 1:13,

And you hath he quickened, who were dead in trespasses and sins; Ephesians 2:1

Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;)

Ephesians 2:5

And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses;

Colossians 2:13

And if you do already know the risen Saviour Jesus Christ as presented to you by Paul from a KJB1611,
Comfort your hearts, and stablish you in every good word and work.
