



Paul's Greater Commission

Teaching the 'Goodness of God' During the Dispensation of the Grace of God



Is your life a shipwreck... or maybe you know it is headed for one? Highlights from Acts 27

- 9 Now when much time was spent, and when sailing was now dangerous, because the fast was now already past, <u>Paul admonished them</u>, And said unto them, Sirs, I perceive that this voyage will be with hurt and much damage, not only of the lading and ship, but also of our lives.
 - 11 Nevertheless the centurion believed the master and the owner of the ship, more than those things which were spoken by Paul.
- 13-15 And when the south wind blew softly, <u>supposing that they had obtained their purpose</u>, loosing thence, they sailed close by Crete. But not long after there arose against it a tempestuous wind, called Euroclydon. And when the ship was caught, and <u>could not bear up</u> into the wind, we <u>let her drive</u>.
- 18-20 And we being exceedingly tossed with a tempest, the next <u>day they lightened the ship</u>; And the third day we <u>cast out with our own hands</u> the tackling of the ship. And when neither sun nor stars in many days appeared, and no small tempest lay on us, <u>all hope that we should be saved was then taken away</u>.
 - 21-22 But after long abstinence Paul stood forth in the midst of them, and said, <u>Sirs, ye should have hearkened unto me</u>, and not have loosed from Crete, and to have gained this harm and loss. <u>And now I exhort you to be of good cheer</u>: for there shall be no loss of any man's life among you, but <u>of the ship</u>.

44 And the rest, some on boards, and some on broken pieces of the ship.

And so it came to pass, that they escaped all safe to land.

Just how important is it to have a good spiritual understanding?

Lost people have a worldly yet worthless spiritual understanding as they are without understanding, according to Romans 1:31.

For it is written, I will destroy the wisdom of the wise, and will bring to nothing the understanding of the prudent. I Cor 1:19

"Christians" who live a worldly life and don't seek their understanding and wisdom from the risen Saviour through the writings of the apostle Paul have a darkened understanding.

This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that ye henceforth walk not as other Gentiles walk, in the vanity of their mind, Having the understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart: Who being past feeling have given themselves over unto lasciviousness, to work all uncleanness with greediness. But ye have not so learned Christ; Ephesians 4:15-20

A good spiritual understanding helps us grow up!

Brethren, be not children in understanding: howbeit in malice be ye children, but in understanding be men. That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive; I Corinthians 14:20, Ephesians 4:14

Paul would have us have an enlightened understanding!

For this cause we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of his will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; Colossians 1:9.

The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints, Ephesians 1:18

Wherefore be ye not unwise, but understanding what the will of the Lord is. Ephesians 5:17

Now here is the real 'kicker': We get our understanding from Paul, as our only apostle and is found ONLY in a rightly divided - and read / studied - King James 1611 Bible.

Consider what I say; and the Lord give thee understanding in all things. II Timothy 2:7

Unto All Riches of the Full Assurance of Understanding, to the Acknowledgement of the Mystery of God, and of the Father, and of Christ;

Colossians 2:2

- Develop a more balanced scriptural boldness & spiritual confidence!
- Knowing your spiritual gifts from the correct dispensation for today!
- Fighting the right battles knowing you will still win the final eternal war!
- Knowing your good, and acceptable, and perfect will of God in your life!
- Love His appearing, not just your disappearing!
- A total awareness of cunningly devised fables in detail exactly as Paul warns!
- Awareness of the doctrines of devils and seducing spirits that deceive & destroy!
- A watchful awareness of when truth is being evil spoken of!
- The ability to identify the spirit of anti-Christ everywhere it exists today!
- Eliminate confusion from the modern bibles found in churches today teaching various doctrines, producing false salvations and confusing religious issues!
- Eliminate one's personal doubts about salvation while knowing truth in the world situation, including everything from the past, the present and the future!
- Strive to have a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty in your home!
- Correctly hear the voices of joy and gladness that are true to the scriptures!
- Able to find, hear, identify and study to know the true voice of the risen Christ!
- Be of those that can truly say, "Praise the Lord of hosts... of them who bring the sacrifice of praise to themselves according to the scriptures today concerning music!
- Mark all the good voices as well as mark the bad voices that exist in the world!
- Receive scripturally proper encouragement from the **Psalms**!
- Receive better and proper divided guidance from the wisdom in **Proverbs!**
- Learn how not to get caught up into doubtful disputations!
- Able to steer clear of conversations and studies that bring about more questions and gender strife, even if they come from your favorite person or pastor!
- Better identify vain babblings and to stay away from them... and why!
- Able to live a proper godliness without any pastoral guilt or self bondage!
- Scriptural strength to identify, accept, and follow sound doctrine!
- Be assured that your sins are all forgiven and there is no sin to even be imputed!
- Understand how to live in the newness of life and newness of spirit daily!
- Eliminate your need and dependence on social welfare and recovery programs!
- Know and discern the exact wording of the scriptures 'for' us as well as 'to' us!

- Learn to prepare and use your sword; it is more than just owning the "right one!"
- Learn to withdraw & turn away from those who reject the truth!
- Know the truth during these latter times, especially for the local church!
- Awareness and ability to identify all apostasy and all the evil that comes with it!
- Better identify those seducing evil men and their good words and fair speeches!
- Prepare for your own judgment seat knowing it is all based on Paul's gospel only!
- Learn to have a proper & godly 'manner of life' based on Paul's teachings!
- Have more appreciation for what God has done, is doing, and will do to & for you!
- Know the things Paul expects us to know as we learn to follow the risen Christ!
- Know exactly what to teach your children and grandkids about the living God!
- Learn how to please God and then do it according to the scriptures not because of fear and bondage but because it is our 'reasonable service' to God!
- Give God glory in all that you say & do and stop quenching & grieving the Spirit!
- Enjoy the true peace of God, the peace from God, and peace with God!

Therefore I write these things being absent, lest being present I should use sharpness, according to the power which the Lord hath given me to edification, and not to destruction. II Cor 13:10

And the soldiers' counsel was to kill the prisoners, lest any of them should swim out, and escape.

But the centurion, willing to save Paul, kept them from their purpose; and commanded that they which could swim should cast themselves first into the sea, and get to land:

And the rest, some on boards, and some on broken pieces of the ship.

And so it came to pass, that they escaped all safe to land.

Because you see, they all finally hearkened unto Paul!

"You should hearken unto Paul!"
